Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Anderson has 116 recorded vote events across 46 tax-related bills: 109 Yea, 7 Nay, 0 Present/Not Voting (X), 0 Present (P), and 0 Abstain (A). 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 103 events on 45 tax bills (97 Yea, 6 Nay, 0 X, 0 A). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30: 12 Yea and 1 Nay. Special I has one Nay. There is no Special I X. There is no Special I A. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. X=0. A=0. Do not invent an Abstain. Do not invent an X. Do not copy Simonds H0323's three-Nay set onto Anderson.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side. Anderson supported 109 of 116 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The seven Nays are seven recorded actions in her H0386 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent an eighth Nay. The seven Nays, named and unflattened, are 26110685 on SB661 (Passed House with substitute, 57-Y 39-N 1-A); 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A); 26111306 on SB661 (Conference report rejected by House, 49-Y 44-N 3-A); 26111310 on SB661 (Conference report agreed to by House, 57-Y 38-N 1-A); and 26211502 on HB30 Special I (House concurred in Governor's recommendation No. 14, 56-Y 34-N 0-A). Those seven are the complete Nay set. Keep all three SB661 Nays separate. She Nayed the agreed conference on 26111310 as well as the rejected conference on 26111306. Keep the Special I Nay as Nay. The HB145 and HB1279 Nays are Senate-substitute rejections. They are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. This paper does not copy Lily V. Franklin H0393's X on 26110590 onto Anderson. Vote 26110806 on HB30 is N, not X. Vote 26211502 on HB30 Special I is N, not X. Unjoined rows are not scored as tax. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. A=0. Vote 26111306 on SB661 is Nay, not A. Do not invent Downey's A onto this member. Vote 26110137 on HB958, Read third time and passed House (96-Y 1-N 1-A) on 2/10/2026, is Yea. That Yea is not A. Special I is 12 Yea plus 1 Nay. This paper does not write Willett H0327's Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. This paper does not write Simonds H0323's Special I 13 Yea onto this member.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Anderson uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 116 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. X=0. A=0.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 116 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea: 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There is 0 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The seven Nays sit in Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806 and Special I HB30 26211502), Sector/Excise Tax (SB661 26110685, 26111306, and 26111310; HB145 26110807), and Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881). There is no scored X. There is no scored A.

Nay: HB30 Special I — Budget Bill. Vote 26211502 on 6/29/2026. Official recorded action: H House concurred in Governor's recommendation No. 14 (56-Y 34-N 0-A). Anderson's token is N. This is the only Special I Nay. Keep it as Nay. It is rare in this peer set. It is not X. It is not the Regular-session Nay on 26110806. Peers may have Y or X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Anderson recorded Yea on the other twelve Special

I HB30 events, including conference report agreed on 26211488 and Governor's recommendations Nos. 1 through 13. There is no Special I X in this ledger.
