## Executive Assessment

**Bottom line.** Using the disclosed 2026 *is\_tax\_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Anthony has 208 recorded vote events across 88 tax-related bills: 196 Yea, 6 Nay, and 6 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 195 events on 87 tax bills (183 Yea, 6 Nay, 6 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30: 13 Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. X is not Nay and is not absence.

The Regular-session record is one-sided on the Yea side. Anthony supported 196 of 208 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The six Nays are six recorded actions in her H0353 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a seventh Nay. The six Nays, named and unflattened, are H10002V2610609 on HB1199 (Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting, 3-Y 7-N); H10002V2610614 on HB956 (Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting, 4-Y 6-N); 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A); and 26111306 on SB661 (Conference report rejected by House, 49-Y 44-N 3-A). Those six are the complete Nay set. The HB1199 and HB956 Nays are Finance subcommittee recorded actions. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The HB145 and HB1279 Nays are Senate-substitute rejections. They are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. The SB661 Nay is the conference-report rejection on 26111306 only. Vote 26111310 on the later conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A) is Yea for this member. Do not invent 26111310 as Nay. Peers may have X or Y on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. Floor passage of HB1279 on 26110016 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111245 is Yea. Governor's recommendation on 26111389 is Yea. This CSV has four HB1279 events for H0353. This CSV has no Counties, Cities and Towns subcommittee H07002V2610850 or report H07V2611122 for H0353. This paper does not invent those committee tokens. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. House passage of SB388 on 26110528 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111279 is Yea. Governor's recommendation on 26111431 is Yea. SB661 has three recorded events in this CSV: Yea on House passage with substitute (26110685), Nay on conference report rejected (26111306), and Yea on conference report agreed (26111310). Keep 26111306 as Nay. Keep 26111310 as Yea. Do not convert 26111310 to Nay. Do not convert 26111306 to X. HB550 on 2619971 is Yea. SB400 on 26110470 is Yea. This paper does not invent admissions-tax Nays.

Six X tokens stay X. They are not flattened to N and they are not treated as absence. All six sit in 20261. None sit in 20262. The six are H10V2610703 on HB137 (Reported from Finance and referred to Appropriations, 18-Y 0-N); H10001V2611221 on HB991 (Subcommittee recommends laying on the table, 7-Y 2-N); H10001V2611223 on HB958 (Subcommittee recommends reporting, 9-Y 0-N); H10001V2611226 on HB1210 (Subcommittee recommends laying on the table, 7-Y 3-N); H10001V2611227 on HB1211 (Subcommittee recommends laying on the table, 7-Y 3-N); and 26110951 on HB1100 (Senate substitute agreed to by House, 78-Y 19-N 0-A). Keep those six as X. They are not N. They are not Y. Votes H10002V2610609, H10002V2610614, 26110806, 26110807, 26110881, and 26111306 are N, not X. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write Willett H0327's Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. Vote 26110590 on HB30 Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h is Yea for Anthony. It is not X. It is not N. Vote 26110562 on HB30 contested committee amendment Item 54 #1h is Yea for Anthony. It is not X. Unjoined rows are not scored as tax. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Vote 26110137 on HB958 is Yea. That Yea is not A and is not the X on H10001V2611223.

**Interpretive caution.** A high Yea rate does not mean Anthony uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 208 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. A high X count is not absence. The six X tokens are recorded Present/Not

Voting tokens on one Finance referral, four Finance subcommittee rolls, and one Senate-substitute agreement. They are not missing votes and they are not Nays.

## 1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 208 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea: 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 6 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The six Nays sit in Local Taxes (HB1199 H10002V2610609 and HB956 H10002V2610614), Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806), Sector/Excise Tax (HB145 26110807 and SB661 26111306), and Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881). The six X tokens sit in Income Tax (HB137 H10V2610703, HB991 H10001V2611221, HB958 H10001V2611223, HB1210 H10001V2611226, and HB1211 H10001V2611227) and Tax Administration / Other (HB1100 26110951). There is no scored A.

**Documented Fact.** Six Nays. Six X. Zero P. Zero A. The six X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The six Nays named below are Anthony's H0353 CSV tokens. Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a seventh Nay. This paper does not invent HB550 or SB400 Nays. This paper does not invent 26111310 as Nay. This paper does not invent HB1279 floor-passage or conference Nays. Anthony recorded Yea on House passage of HB550, on House passage of SB400, on SB661 House passage with substitute (26110685), and on SB661 conference agreed (26111310).

**Nay: HB1199** — Local license taxes; authority to exempt, businesses regulated by boards within DHP. Vote H10002V2610609 on 1/27/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting (3-Y 7-N). Anthony's token is N. This is a Finance subcommittee recorded action. It is not a House-floor policy Nay. HB1199 has no other H0353 token in this tax universe. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens.

**Nay: HB956** — License taxes; deduction for out-of-state receipts. Vote H10002V2610614 on 1/27/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting (4-Y 6-N). Anthony's token is N. This is a Finance subcommittee recorded action. It is not a House-floor policy Nay. HB956 has no other H0353 token in this tax universe. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens.

**Nay: HB30** — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Anthony's token is N. This is a version/vehicle vote on a forced budget vehicle. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. It is not a standalone tax-rate roll. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Anthony recorded Yea on 38 of 39 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A) on 26110593, Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h on 26110590, and contested committee amendment Item 54 #1h on 26110562. Vote 26110562 is Yea for this member. It is not X. Vote 26110590 is Yea. It is not X and is not this Nay.

**Nay: HB145** — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). Anthony's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Anthony recorded Yea on House passage (89-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26110434; and Yea on the conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26111217. Those Yea tokens are not this Nay. This CSV has three HB145 events for H0353. This paper does not invent Appropriations or General Laws committee tokens absent from this CSV.

**Nay: HB1279** — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A). Anthony's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. This is her only HB1279 Nay. Vote 26110016 on 2/5/2026 is Yea: H Read third time and passed House (60-Y 36-N 0-A). Vote 26111245 on 3/14/2026 is Yea: H Conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A). Vote 26111389 on 4/22/2026 is Yea: H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A). Those Yea tokens are not this Nay. This CSV has four HB1279 events for H0353. This CSV has no Counties, Cities and Towns subcommittee H07002V2610850 or report H07V2611122 for H0353. This paper does not invent those committee tokens.

**Nay: SB661** — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote 26111306 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). Anthony's token is N. This is the conference-report rejection only. Vote 26110685 on 3/3/2026 is Yea: H Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A). Vote 26111310 on 3/14/2026 is Yea: H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Do not invent 26111310 as Nay. Keep 26111310 as Yea. Do not convert 26111306 to X. Peers may have Y, X, or A on 26111306. This paper does not copy those tokens. This CSV has three SB661 events for H0353. This CSV has no SB661 General Laws report vote\_ids for H0353. This paper does not invent those tokens.

**Analysis.** The six Nays are two Finance subcommittee fails (HB1199 H10002V2610609 and HB956 H10002V2610614), one version/vehicle budget event (HB30 26110806), two Senate-substitute rejections (HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881), and one SB661 conference-report rejection (26111306). The two Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. Votes H10V2610703, H10001V2611221, H10001V2611223, H10001V2611226, H10001V2611227, and 26110951 are X, named in section 3. They are not Nays. Vote 26110590 on HB30 is Yea, not X and not N. Vote 26111310 on SB661 is

Yea, not N. This paper does not invent HB550 or SB400 Nays. This paper does not invent HB1279 floor-passage or conference Nays. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. There is no scored A. The six X tokens are not a seventh Nay.

### 3. Present/Not Voting (X)

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**Documented Fact.** Six Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. X is not N. X is not Y. X is not absence. Those six X tokens sit in her CSV. This paper does not invent additional X rows, and it does not copy a peer Y or N onto these events. All six sit in 20261. None sit in 20262. Keep H10V2610703, H10001V2611221, H10001V2611223, H10001V2611226, H10001V2611227, and 26110951 as X. Do not convert any of these X tokens to Nay. Do not invent Dougherty-style X on 26110806 or 26110807 for this member. Those two vote\_ids are N in her CSV. Do not invent Cole-style X on H10002V2610609 or H10002V2610614 for this member. Those two vote\_ids are N in her CSV.

**X: HB137** — Income tax, state; increases current cap of military benefits that may be subtracted. Vote H10V2610703 on 1/28/2026. Official recorded action: H Reported from Finance and referred to Appropriations (18-Y 0-N). Anthony's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. The same day she also recorded Yea on H10V2610715, Reported from Finance with substitute and referred to Appropriations (22-Y 0-N). The subcommittee recommendation on H10001V2610386 is Yea. Keep H10V2610703 as X.

**X: HB991** — Income tax, state; subtraction for volunteer firefighters and emergency medical services personnel. Vote H10001V2611221 on 2/2/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 2-N). Anthony's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. This is the only HB991 event in this ledger. This paper does not invent later HB991 Finance or floor tokens.

**X: HB958** — Income tax, corporate; taxable income, net operating loss. Vote H10001V2611223 on 2/2/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting (9-Y 0-N). Anthony's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. Later tokens on HB958 are Yea: Finance report H10V2611729 and House passage 26110137 (96-Y 1-N 1-A). Vote 26110137 is Yea, not A and not this X.

**X: HB1210** — Income tax, state; subtraction for long-term capital gains from sale of principal residence. Vote H10001V2611226 on 2/2/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N). Anthony's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. This is the only HB1210 event in this ledger.

**X: HB1211** — Income tax, state; first-time homebuyer tax credit. Vote H10001V2611227 on 2/2/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N). Anthony's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. This is the only HB1211 event in this ledger.

**X: HB1100** — Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. Vote 26110951 on 3/10/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute agreed to by House (78-Y 19-N 0-A). Anthony's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. House passage on 26110125 is Yea. Governor's recommendation on 26111384 is Yea. Keep 26110951 as X.

There are 0 Present (P) and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Votes H10002V2610609, H10002V2610614, 26110806, 26110807, 26110881, and 26111306 are N, not X. Votes H10V2610703, H10001V2611221, H10001V2611223, H10001V2611226, H10001V2611227, and 26110951 are X, not N. Vote 26110590 is Yea, not X. Vote 26110562 is Yea, not X. Vote 26110137 on HB958 is Yea, not A. Vote 26111310 on SB661 is Yea, not N.

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Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. The HB854 Senate-substitute token on 26110865 is Yea. The House-agreement token on HJ34 2619884 is Yea for this member. It is not X. This CSV has no HJ34 subcommittee or Rules report.

**HB10.** Real property tax; classification of land and improvements. Anthony recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (10-Y 0-N).

**HB72.** Real property tax; classification of land and improvements in City of Fredericksburg. Anthony recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (9-Y 1-N).

**HB175.** Real property; tax exemption, surviving spouses of members of Armed Forces who died in line of duty. Anthony recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (10-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/28/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (22-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

**HB557.** Tangible personal property tax; establishes classification for electric landscaping equipment. Anthony recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (7-Y 3-N); Yea on 2/4/2026, H Reported from Finance (15-Y 7-N); Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

**HB566.** Tangible personal property tax relief; rate of taxation. Anthony recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N).

**HB697.** Income tax, state; credit for surviving spouse's real property taxes. Anthony recorded Yea on 2/11/2026, H Reported from Finance and referred to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N).

**HB854.** Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. **HB1051.** Income tax, state; real property tax relief credit. Anthony recorded Yea on 2/2/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N).

**HB1205.** Motor vehicles insurance; hwy. use fee, tangible personal property tax relief for certain vehicles. Anthony recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N).

**SB181.** Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. Anthony recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (11-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (17-Y 4-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with substitute (70-Y 29-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (65-Y 31-N 0-A).

This paper does not invent those committee tokens. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. The House-passage token on SB388 26110528 is Yea. The conference token on 26111279 is Yea. The Governor's-recommendation token on 26111431 is Yea. HB400 26110809, Senate substitute agreed to by House (70-Y 24-N 0-A), is Yea. **Comparative significance.** Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Anthony's N on H10002V2610609 and H10002V2610614 where peers may have X, her N on 26110806 where peers may have X, her N on 26110807 and 26110881 where peers may have X, her N on SB661 26111306 where peers may have Y, X, or A, her Yea on SB661 26111310 where peers may have X or N, her X on HB137 H10V2610703, HB991, HB958 subcommittee, HB1210, HB1211, and HB1100 26110951 where peers often recorded Y, her Yea on HB30 26110562 where peers may have X, her Yea on HB550 2619971 and SB400 26110470 where peers may have N, her Yea on shared-refid 26110723 where some peers recorded X, her Yea on HB1279 conference 26111245 and SB388 conference 26111279 where some peers recorded X, and her Special I 13 Yea rather than a 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted. This ledger is H0353 only. H0177 tokens are not scored. H0334 tokens are not scored. H0340 tokens are not scored. **Open Question.** Version text on the HB145 and HB1279 Senate substitutes versus the later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Version text on the SB661 House-substitute vehicle and the two conference reports is not compared. Why Anthony recorded N on 26111306 and Y on 26111310 on the same calendar day is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens. Senate-amendment text on 20261 HB30 26110806 is not lined to any single tax item. Why Anthony's token on H10V2610703, H10001V2611221, H10001V2611223, H10001V2611226, H10001V2611227, and 26110951 is X while peers often recorded Y is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens.

- Shared-refid blocks (26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, 2619915) — all six are Yea. Do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position. Do not copy a peer X onto 26110723.
- HISTORY join gaps: 51 unjoined 20261 vote\_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote\_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed. 26110458X is a trailing-X duplicate; unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29 as Yea when present. This paper does not invent a tax bill from that suffix row.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.
