Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Carroll has 179 recorded vote events across 63 tax-related bills: 164 Yea, 7 Nay, and 8 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 166 events on 62 tax bills (151 Yea, 7 Nay, 8 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. X is not Nay and is not absence.

The Regular-session record is one-sided on the Yea side. Carroll supported 164 of 179 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The seven Nays are seven recorded actions in her H0388 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent an eighth Nay. The seven Nays, named and unflattened, are H10002V2610609 on HB1199 (Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting, 3-Y 7-N); H10002V2612603 on HB919 (Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute, 7-Y 2-N); H10002V2612619 on HB919 (Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute, 5-Y 4-N); H10V2612760 on HB919 (Reported from Finance with substitute, 14-Y 7-N); 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); and 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A). Those seven are the complete Nay set. Do not collapse the three HB919 Nays into one Nay. HB919 has three recorded Nays and no Yea in this CSV. The HB1199 Nay is a Finance subcommittee recorded action. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The HB145 and HB1279 Nays are Senate-substitute rejections. They are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. Peers may have X on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. SB661 has five recorded events in this CSV: Yea on both General Laws reports (H11V2613579, H11V2613582), Yea on House passage with substitute (26110685), and X on both conference events (26111306 conference rejected; 26111310 conference agreed). Keep both SB661 conference tokens as X. Do not convert SB661 conference to Nay. This paper does not invent an SB661 Nay. HB550 on 2619971 is Yea. SB400 on 26110470 is Yea. This paper does not invent admissions-tax Nays.

Eight X tokens stay X. They are not flattened to N and they are not treated as absence. All eight sit in 20261. Special I has no X. The eight are 26110458 on HB29 (Senate amendments agreed to by House, 59-Y 35-N 0-A); 26110507 on HB30 (Motion for Special and Continuing Order, 93-Y 0-N 0-A); 26111194 on SB129 (Conference report agreed, 88-Y 7-N 0-A); 26111217 on HB145 (Conference report agreed, 87-Y 8-N 0-A); 26111245 on HB1279 (Conference report agreed, 54-Y 41-N 0-A); 26111279 on SB388 (Conference report agreed, 55-Y 40-N 0-A); 26111306 on SB661 (Conference report rejected, 49-Y 44-N 3-A); and 26111310 on SB661 (Conference report agreed, 57-Y 38-N 1-A). Both SB661 conference tokens are X in her CSV. Peers may have N on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens and does not convert those X tokens to Nay. Unjoined rows are not scored as tax. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write a Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member.

The recorded universe is 179 events on 63 tax bills because H0388 tokens joined tax bills, including Finance committee and subcommittee rolls and General Laws rolls. Sixty-five of the 179 events carry H10 vote_id prefixes. Four carry H11 prefixes. Twenty-eight carry H10002 prefixes. That is a CSV join count. This paper does not invent a reason beyond the CSV. This paper does not backfill unjoined IDs.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Carroll uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee and subcommittee rolls, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 179 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. A high X count is not absence. The eight Regular-session X tokens are recorded Present/Not Voting tokens on Senate-amendment agreement, a Special and Continuing Order motion, and six conference-report rolls. They are not missing votes and they are not Nays.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 179 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea: 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 8 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The seven Nays sit in Sales & Use Tax (HB919 H10002V2612603, H10002V2612619, and H10V2612760), Tax Administration / Other (HB1199 H10002V2610609), Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806), Sector/Excise Tax (HB145 26110807), and Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881). The eight X tokens sit in Budget / Appropriations (HB29 26110458; HB30 26110507), Sector/Excise Tax (SB129 26111194; HB145 26111217; SB661 26111306 and 26111310), and Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26111245; SB388 26111279). There is no scored A.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Seven Nays. Eight X. Zero P. Zero A. The eight X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The seven Nays named below are Carroll's H0388 CSV tokens. HB1199 appears once as N. HB919 appears three times as N. HB30 appears once as N. HB145 appears once as N. HB1279 appears once as N. Those are separate recorded actions. Do not collapse the three HB919 Nays into one Nay. This paper does not invent an eighth Nay. This paper does not invent SB661 Nays. Both SB661 conference tokens are X and are named in section 3.

Nay: HB1199 — Local license taxes; authority to exempt, businesses regulated by boards within DHP. Vote H10002V2610609 on 1/27/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting (3-Y 7-N). Carroll's token is N. This is a Finance subcommittee recorded action. It is not a House-floor policy Nay. HB1199 has no other H0388 token in this tax universe.

Nay: HB919 — Retail Sales and Use Tax; impose firearm and ammunition tax. Three recorded Nays on this bill. Do not collapse them.

Vote H10002V2612603 on 2/10/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (7-Y 2-N). Carroll's token is N. This is the first of three HB919 Nays.

Vote H10002V2612619 on 2/10/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (5-Y 4-N). Carroll's token is N. This is the second of three HB919 Nays. It is not the same roll as H10002V2612603.

Vote H10V2612760 on 2/11/2026. Official recorded action: H Reported from Finance with substitute (14-Y 7-N). Carroll's token is N. This is the third of three HB919 Nays. It is the Finance committee report. This CSV has no later HB919 floor or conference event for H0388. This paper does not invent one. Peers may have Yea on these HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Carroll's token is N. This is a version/vehicle vote on a forced budget vehicle. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. It is not a standalone tax-rate roll. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Carroll recorded Yea on 37 of 39 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A) on 26110593 and Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h on 26110590. Vote 26110507 on HB30 Motion for Special and Continuing Order is X, named in section 3, and is not this Nay. All 13 Special I HB30 events are Yea.

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). Carroll's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Carroll recorded Yea on General Laws report referred to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N), vote H11V2610929; and Yea on House passage (89-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26110434. Vote 26111217, conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A), is X for Carroll and is named in section 3. Those Yea and X tokens are not this Nay.

Nay: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. One recorded Nay on this bill, the Senate-substitute rejection:

Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A). Carroll's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. This is her only HB1279 Nay.

Vote 26110016 on 2/5/2026 is Yea: H Read third time and passed House (60-Y 36-N 0-A). Vote 26111245 on 3/14/2026 is X: H Conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A). That conference token stays X and is named in section 3. Vote 26111389 on 4/22/2026 is Yea: H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A). Those Yea and X tokens are not this Nay. This paper does not invent floor-passage or conference Nays on HB1279.

Analysis. The seven Nays are one Finance subcommittee Nay (HB1199), three HB919 Finance subcommittee and committee Nays that stay unflattened, one version/vehicle budget event (HB30 26110806), and two Senate-substitute rejections (HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881). The two Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The HB1199 and HB919 Nays are committee and subcommittee recorded actions. This paper does not invent HB550 or SB400 Nays. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. SB661 has no Nay in this ledger. Both SB661 conference tokens stay X. There is no scored A. The eight X tokens are not an eighth Nay.

3. Present/Not Voting (X)

Documented Fact. Eight Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. X is not N. X is not Y. X is not absence. Those eight X tokens sit in her CSV. This paper does not invent additional X rows, and it does not copy a peer Y or N onto these events. All eight sit in 20261. Special I has no X. Do not convert either SB661 conference X to Nay.

X: HB29 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110458 on 2/20/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments agreed to by House (59-Y 35-N 0-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. Peers may have Yea on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Carroll recorded Yea on the other five 20261 HB29 events in this ledger, including House passage (63-Y 35-N 0-A) on 26110131. The trailing-X duplicate 26110458X is unjoined and is not scored as tax.

X: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110507 on 2/25/2026. Official recorded action: H Motion for Special and Continuing Order for Thursday, February 26, 2026 (93-Y 0-N 0-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. It is not the Senate-amendments Nay on 26110806. Vote 26110590 on Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h is Yea. Vote 26110593 on House passage is Yea.

X: SB129 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26111194 on 3/13/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (88-Y 7-N 0-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. Carroll recorded Yea on General Laws report with substitute referred to Appropriations (H11V2613577) and Yea on House passage with substitute (26110761). Keep 26111194 as X.

X: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26111217 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. It is not the Senate-substitute Nay on 26110807. Keep 26111217 as X.

X: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26111245 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. It is not the Senate-substitute Nay on 26110881. Keep 26111245 as X.

X: SB388 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26111279 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. Carroll recorded Yea on House passage with amendments (26110528) and Yea on Governor's recommendation (26111431). Keep 26111279 as X.

X: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote 26111306 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. Peers may have N on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Do not convert this X to Nay.

X: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote 26111310 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Carroll's token is X. It is not N. Peers may have N on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Do not convert this X to Nay. It is not the conference-rejected X on 26111306. Carroll recorded Yea on both General Laws reports (H11V2613579, H11V2613582) and Yea on House passage with substitute (26110685). Those Yea tokens are not these X tokens.

There are 0 Present (P) and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Votes H10002V2610609, H10002V2612603, H10002V2612619, H10V2612760, 26110806, 26110807, and 26110881 are N, not X. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write a Special I X cluster onto this member. Vote 26110137 on HB958 (House passage, 96-Y 1-N 1-A) is Yea, not A.

4. Real & Personal Property Tax

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Shared-refid property titles that also appear in concatenated blocks are listed once in section

7 with their block events so a single roll call is not narrated twice when it is shared. Exact-bill Finance and floor events for those titles still appear below when present as single-bill rows. The HB854 Senate-substitute token on 26110865 is Yea. The House-agreement token on HJ34 2619884 is Yea.

HB175. Real property; tax exemption, surviving spouses of members of Armed Forces who died in line of duty. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (10-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/21/2026, H Reported from Finance (22-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (99-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB282. Real property tax; classification of land and improvement in Cities of Charlottesville/Falls Church. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (9-Y 1-N); Yea on 1/21/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (21-Y 1-N); Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (91-Y 8-N 0-A).

HB854. Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (8-Y 1-N); Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (9-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/28/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (22-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (90-Y 5-N 0-A).

HB474. Real estate with delinquent taxes or liens; apptmt. of special commissioner, increases value. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (10-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/28/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (22-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. Carroll recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (11-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (17-Y 4-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with substitute (70-Y 29-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (65-Y 31-N 0-A).

HB557. Tangible personal property tax; establishes classification for electric landscaping equipment. Carroll recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (7-Y 3-N); Yea on 2/4/2026, H Reported from Finance (15-Y 7-N); Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

HJ34. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, H Agreed to by House (68-Y 25-N 0-A).

HB10. Real property tax; classification of land and improvements. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (10-Y 0-N).

HB72. Real property tax; classification of land and improvements in City of Fredericksburg. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (9-Y 1-N).

HB261. Real property; tax classification of land and improvements in City of Newport News. Carroll recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (9-Y 1-N).

HB400 26110809, Senate substitute agreed to by House (70-Y 24-N 0-A), is Yea. HB958 26110137 is Yea. That Yea is not A and is not X. SB612 26110475 is Yea.

HB400. Motion picture production; increases aggregate cap on tax credit, extends sunset. SB388. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Carroll recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Passed House with amendments (61-Y 37-N 0-A); Present/Not Voting (X) on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 36-N 0-A).

HB12. Income tax, state; standard deduction. Carroll recorded Yea on 2/9/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 2-N).

The seven Nays are seven recorded actions: HB1199 Finance subcommittee failed to recommend reporting (H10002V2610609, 3-Y 7-N); HB919 subcommittee recommend with substitute (H10002V2612603, 7-Y 2-N); HB919 subcommittee recommend with substitute (H10002V2612619, 5-Y 4-N); HB919 Finance report with substitute (H10V2612760, 14-Y 7-N); HB30 Senate amendments rejected (26110806, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); HB145 Senate substitute rejected (26110807, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); and HB1279 Senate substitute rejected (26110881, 0-Y 95-N 0-A). Those seven are the complete Nay set. Do not collapse the three HB919 Nays. The two Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The HB1199 and HB919 Nays are committee and subcommittee recorded actions. Vote 26110590 on HB30 Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h is Yea, not X. HB550 2619971 is Yea. SB400 26110470 is Yea. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, Finance and General Laws committee rolls, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad Regular-session support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus, with a documented seven-event Nay set that includes three unflattened HB919 committee and subcommittee Nays, one HB1199 subcommittee Nay, two procedural Senate-substitute rejections, and one budget version/vehicle Nay, plus eight Present/Not Voting tokens including both SB661 conference events as X and a full Special I Yea string on HB30, than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Carroll has eight X tokens in this tax universe and zero Present (P) and zero Abstain (A) tokens. X is not Nay and is not absence. All eight X tokens sit in Regular session. Special I is 13 Yea on HB30. Shared-refid events 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915 are Yea. Vote 26110137 on HB958 (House passage, 96-Y 1-N 1-A) is Yea, not A.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Carroll's three HB919 Nays where peers may have Yea or X, her HB1199 subcommittee Nay, her Nay on 26110806 where peers may have X, her Nay on 26110807 and 26110881 where peers may have X, her X on HB145 conference 26111217 and HB1279 conference 26111245 where peers may have Yea, her X on both SB661 conference events where peers may have N or Y, her Yea on HB550 2619971 and SB400 26110470 where peers may have N, her Yea on shared-refid 26110723 where some peers recorded X, and her Special I 13 Yea rather than a Present/Not Voting cluster. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted. This ledger is H0388 only. H0177 tokens are not scored. H0334 tokens are not scored. H0340 tokens are not scored. H0404 tokens are not scored. H0393 tokens are not scored.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 and HB1279 Senate substitutes versus the later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Senate-amendment text on 20261 HB30 26110806 is not lined to any single tax item. Floor-amendment Item 4-14 #1h text on 26110590 is not lined to any single tax item. Governor-recommendation text on 20262 HB30 is not lined to any single tax item. Why both SB661 conference tokens are X while House

passage on 26110685 is Yea is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens. Why the three HB919 committee and subcommittee tokens are all N is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens.

Methodology & Evidence Limits

- Subject lock: official LIS member ID H0388, name token Stacey Annie Carroll. House District 64 | HD-64 | Stafford (part) | Democrat is the task identity for this product. Members.csv columns on disk are MBR_HOU, MBR_MBRNO, and MBR_NAME only; they do not print party or district. Official member page: <https://house.vga.virginia.gov/members/H0388> This ledger is H0388 only. Do not use H0177, H0334, H0340, H0404, or H0393 as the subject of this paper.
- Universe = H0388 token in VOTE.CSV joined to a bill that passes build_taxes.is_tax_bill (imported, not rewritten): keyword plus Title 58.1 summary plus forced budget vehicles (HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30/(HB | SB)600x), minus land-use-only data-center false positives. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. Budget vehicles and version votes sit in the same filter. Finance committee (H10) and related subcommittee vote_ids (H10002) and General Laws (H11) sit in the same filter when they join HISTORY. Sixty-five of the 179 events carry H10 prefixes. Four carry H11 prefixes. Twenty-eight carry H10002 prefixes. That join is why this ledger counts 179 events on 63 tax bills. This paper does not invent a reason beyond the CSV.
- Join: vote_id.strip() == History_refid.strip(). Unique events are counted as (session, vote_id). CSV rows = 179 (20261 = 166, 20262 = 13). Token mix: Y=164, N=7, X=8, P=0, A=0. Unique tax bills with at least one H0388 token: 63 (20261 = 62, 20262 = 1). 20261 and 20262 are not collapsed in the appendix.
- The Martinez first-pass paper screen of 34/26/33/1 is a different denominator. This ledger was not forced to look like that screen.
- 2025 files and va-member-votes-wide.csv were not used.
- HISTORY join gaps: 52 unjoined unique 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined unique 20262 vote_ids cannot be assigned a bill and were not scored as tax. Bills were not invented for those IDs. 26110458X (token=X) is a VOTE.CSV duplicate row with a trailing X on the vote_id. The unsuffixed 26110458 does join to HB29 as X and is not copied onto the suffix row. This paper does not invent a tax bill from that suffix row.
- Six shared-refid events concatenate multiple tax bills with ";" and remain one KPI event and one ledger row, all Yea: 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915. Vote 26110723 is Y.
- 20262 is HB30 only: 13 events, all Yea (26211488 and 26211491 through 26211502). Other Special Session tax bills were not invented. Unjoined 26211490 is not backfilled. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X cluster in the scored tax universe.
- A token on a substitute is the recorded token on that action. HB1199 H10002V2610609 is N on subcommittee failed to recommend reporting. HB919 H10002V2612603, H10002V2612619, and H10V2612760 are three separate Nays and are not collapsed. HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881 are N on Senate substitute rejected by House.
