Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Glass has 110 recorded vote events across 46 tax-related bills: 101 Yea, 9 Nay, 0 Present/Not Voting (X), 0 Present (P), and 0 Abstain (A). 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 97 events on 45 tax bills (88 Yea, 9 Nay, 0 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. X=0. A=0. Do not invent an Abstain. Do not invent an X. Do not copy Anthony H0353's six X onto Glass.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side. Glass supported 101 of 110 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The nine Nays are nine recorded actions in her H0349 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a tenth Nay. The nine Nays, named and unflattened, are 26110528 on SB388 (Passed House with amendments, 61-Y 37-N 0-A); 26110685 on SB661 (Passed House with substitute, 57-Y 39-N 1-A); 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A); 26111245 on HB1279 (Conference report agreed to by House, 54-Y 41-N 0-A); 26111279 on SB388 (Conference report agreed to by House, 55-Y 40-N 0-A); 26111306 on SB661 (Conference report rejected by House, 49-Y 44-N 3-A); and 26111310 on SB661 (Conference report agreed to by House, 57-Y 38-N 1-A). Those nine are the complete Nay set. Keep both SB388 Nays separate. Keep both SB661 conference votes separate from the House-passage Nay. Keep the HB1279 conference Nay separate from the HB1279 Senate-substitute Nay. Vote 26110685 on SB661 is N, not X. Peers may have X or Y on that HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. The HB145 and HB1279 Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. The Regular-session HB30 Nay on 26110806 is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. Conference-agreed N on HB1279 26111245, SB388 26111279, and SB661 26111310 is still N. HB550 on 2619971 is Yea. SB400 on 26110470 is Yea. This paper does not invent admissions-tax Nays. This CSV has no General Laws SB661 report tokens for H0349. This paper does not invent H11V2613579 or H11V2613582.

There is 0 Present/Not Voting (X) token in this tax universe. X=0. This paper does not invent an X. Do not copy Anthony H0353's six X onto Glass. Vote 26110590 on HB30, Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h offered by Delegate McNamara passed by (62-Y 33-N 0-A) on 2/26/2026, is Yea for Glass. It is not X. It is not N. This paper does not copy Lily V. Franklin H0393's X on 26110590 onto Glass. Vote 26110806 on HB30 is N, not X. Vote 26110685 on SB661 is N, not X. Unjoined rows are not scored as tax. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. A=0. Vote 26111306 on SB661 is Nay, not A. Vote 26110137 on HB958, Read third time and passed House (96-Y 1-N 1-A) on 2/10/2026, is Yea. That Yea is not A. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write a Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member.

The recorded universe is 110 events on 46 tax bills because H0349 tokens joined tax bills on the floor rolls that attach to this CSV. There are 0 H02 Appropriations-prefixed vote_ids and 0 H11 General Laws-prefixed vote_ids in this ledger. That is a CSV join count. This paper does not invent a reason beyond the CSV. This paper does not backfill unjoined IDs.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Glass uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 110 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. X=0. A=0.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration /

Other so the table sums to 110 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea: 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There is 0 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The nine Nays sit in Sector/Excise Tax (SB661 26110685, 26111306, and 26111310; HB145 26110807), Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881 and 26111245; SB388 26110528 and 26111279), and Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806). There is no scored X. There is no scored A.

Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a tenth Nay. This paper does not flatten the three SB661 Nays into one Nay. This paper does not flatten the two SB388 Nays into one Nay. This paper does not flatten the two HB1279 Nays into one Nay. This paper does not invent HB550 or SB400 Nays. Glass recorded Yea on House passage of HB550 and on House passage of SB400. Glass recorded Nay on House passage of SB388 with amendments, on House passage of SB661 with substitute, on both SB661 conference reports, on HB1279 Senate substitute rejected, on HB1279 conference report agreed, on SB388 conference report agreed, on HB145 Senate substitute rejected, and on HB30 Senate amendments rejected. Vote 26110685 is Nay, not X. Vote 26110528 is Nay. Vote 26111245 is Nay. Vote 26111279 is Nay. Keep both SB388 Nays separate. Keep both conference votes on SB661 separate. Keep the HB1279 conference Nay separate from the Senate-substitute Nay.

It is not the conference Nay on 26111279. Peers may have Y or X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Do not copy Price H0284's Yea on 26110528 onto Glass.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote 26110685 on 3/3/2026. Official recorded action: H Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A). Glass's token is N. This is the first of three SB661 Nays. It is a recorded token on House passage with substitute. It is not X. Peers may have Y or X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Do not copy Callsen H0354's X on 26110685 onto Glass. This CSV has no General Laws SB661 report tokens for H0349. This paper does not invent H11V2613579 or H11V2613582.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Glass's token is N. This is a version/vehicle vote on a forced budget vehicle. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. It is not a standalone tax-rate roll. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Glass recorded Yea on 38 of 39 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A) on 26110593 and Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h on 26110590. Vote 26110590 is Yea. It is not X and is not this Nay. All 13 Special I HB30 events are Yea. This CSV has no Appropriations H02 report token on HB30 for H0349.

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). Glass's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Glass recorded Yea on House passage (89-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26110434; and Yea on the conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26111217. Those Yea tokens are not this Nay. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A). Glass's token is N. Conference-agreed N is still N on that action. This is the second of two SB388 Nays. It is not the House-passage Nay on 26110528. This paper does not flatten those two SB388 recorded actions into one Nay. Peers may have Y or X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Do not copy Callsen H0354's Yea on 26111279 onto Glass. Vote 26111431 on 4/22/2026 is Yea: H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 36-N 0-A). That Yea token is not these Nays. This CSV has three SB388 events. This paper does not invent a Counties, Cities and Towns report absent from this CSV.

It is not the House-passage Nay on 26110685. It is not the conference-agreed Nay on 26111310. Peers may have Y, A, or X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote 26111310 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Glass's token is N. Conference-agreed N is still N on that action. This is the third of three SB661 Nays. She Nayed the agreed conference too. It is not the conference-rejected Nay on 26111306. This paper does not flatten those two conference recorded actions into one Nay. Peers may have Y or X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens.

Analysis. All three SB661 events in this ledger are Nay and are named in section 2: 26110685 (House passage with substitute), 26111306 (conference report rejected), and 26111310 (conference report agreed). None is X. None is A. None is Yea. Peers may have Y, X, or A on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. Do not copy Callsen H0354's X on 26110685 onto Glass. This CSV has no General Laws SB661 report for H0349.

HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110590 on 2/26/2026. Official recorded action: H Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h offered by Delegate McNamara passed by (62-Y 33-N 0-A). Glass's token is Yea. It is not X. It is not N. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. This paper does not copy Lily V. Franklin H0393's X on 26110590 onto Glass. Glass recorded Yea on 38 of 39 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A), and N on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments. Special I is 13 Yea. There is no Special I Nay and no Special I X.

HB958 — Income tax, corporate; taxable income, net operating loss. Vote 26110137 on 2/10/2026. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (96-Y 1-N 1-A). Glass's token is Yea. It is not A. It is not X. It is not N. This paper does not treat this roll as an Abstain. This is the only HB958 event in this ledger. There is no A in this tax universe.

HB854. Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. Glass recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (90-Y 5-N 0-A).

HB474. Real estate with delinquent taxes or liens; apptmt. of special commissioner, increases value. Glass recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. Glass recorded Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with substitute (70-Y 29-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (65-Y 31-N 0-A).

HB557. Tangible personal property tax; establishes classification for electric landscaping equipment. Glass recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

HJ34. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. Glass recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, H Agreed to by House (68-Y 25-N 0-A).

5. Income Tax, Credits & Exemptions

This CSV has four HB1279 events. This paper does not invent subcommittee tokens absent from this CSV. SB388 has two Nays: the House-passage token on 26110528 is N, and the conference token on 26111279 is N. Keep both SB388 Nays separate. The Governor's-recommendation token on 26111431 is Yea. This CSV has three SB388 events. HB400 events in this ledger are Yea, including House passage on 26110305 and Senate substitute agreed on 26110809. SB612 House passage on 26110475 is Yea. The HB334 House-passage token on 2619835 is Yea. The HB341 House-passage token on 2619836 is Yea. The HB915 House-passage token on 26110118 is Yea.

The unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29 as Yea. The trailing-X duplicate 26110458X is unjoined and is not scored as tax. This paper does not invent a bill for 26110458X. This CSV has no Appropriations H02 report token on HB29 for H0349.

There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X in the scored tax universe. This paper does not write a Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). Glass supported 101 of 110 recorded tax-universe events. The nine Nays are nine recorded actions: SB388 House passage with amendments (26110528, 61-Y 37-N 0-A); SB661 House passage with substitute (26110685, 57-Y 39-N 1-A); HB30 Senate amendments rejected (26110806, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); HB145 Senate substitute rejected (26110807, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); HB1279 Senate substitute rejected (26110881, 0-Y 95-N 0-A); HB1279 conference report agreed (26111245, 54-Y 41-N 0-A); SB388 conference report agreed (26111279, 55-Y 40-N 0-A); SB661 conference report rejected (26111306, 49-Y 44-N 3-A); and SB661 conference report agreed (26111310, 57-Y 38-N 1-A). Those nine are the complete Nay set. Keep both SB388 Nays separate. Keep both SB661 conference votes separate. Keep the HB1279 conference Nay separate from the Senate-substitute Nay. The two Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. The Regular HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. Conference-agreed N on 26111245, 26111279, and 26111310 is still N. Vote 26110685 is Nay, not X. Vote 26110590 on HB30 Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h is Yea, not X. HB550 2619971 is Yea. SB400 26110470 is Yea. This paper does not invent admissions-tax Nays. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus, with a documented nine-event Nay set that includes a three-event SB661 string kept unflattened, a two-event SB388 string

kept unflattened, two procedural Senate-substitute rejections, one Regular budget version/vehicle Nay, and one HB1279 conference-agreed Nay, and with zero Present/Not Voting tokens and zero Abstain tokens, than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Glass has zero X tokens in this tax universe, zero Present (P) tokens, and zero Abstain (A) tokens. X is not Nay and is not absence. A is not Nay and is not X. Do not copy Anthony H0353's six X onto Glass. Vote 26110685 stays Nay. Vote 26110528 stays Nay. Vote 26111245 stays Nay. Vote 26111279 stays Nay. Vote 26111310 stays Nay. Vote 26110590 stays Yea. Vote 26110137 on HB958 (House passage, 96-Y 1-N 1-A) is Yea, not A. There is no Special I X cluster in the scored tax universe. Special I is 13 Yea on HB30. Shared-refid events 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915 are Yea.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Glass's Yea on 26110590 where peers may have X, her Nay on 26110806 where peers may have X, her Nay on 26110807 and 26110881 where peers may have X, her Yea on HB550 2619971 and SB400 26110470 where peers may have N, her three Nays on SB661 26110685, 26111306, and 26111310 where peers may have Y, X, or A, her Nay on SB388 House passage 26110528 where peers may have Y, her Nay on HB1279 conference 26111245 where peers may have Y or X, her Nay on SB388 conference 26111279 where peers may have Y or X, her Yea on shared-refid 26110723 where some peers recorded X, her zero X rather than Anthony's six X, and her Special I 13 Yea rather than a Present/Not Voting cluster. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted. This ledger is H0349 only. H0177 tokens are not scored. H0334 tokens are not scored. H0340 tokens are not scored. H0404 tokens are not scored. H0393 tokens are not scored. H0353 tokens are not scored. H0354 tokens are not scored. H0284 tokens are not scored.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 and HB1279 Senate substitutes versus the later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Version text on the SB661 House-substitute vehicle and the two conference reports is not compared. Senate-amendment text on 20261 HB30 26110806 is not lined to any single tax item. Floor-amendment Item 4-14 #1h text on 26110590 is not lined to any single tax item. Why Glass's tokens on SB661 are Nay while peers may have Y, X, or A is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens. Why the SB388 House-passage and conference tokens are Nay while the Governor-recommendation token is Yea is not established beyond the recorded tokens. Why the HB1279 conference token is Nay while the House-passage and Governor-recommendation tokens are Yea is not established beyond the recorded tokens.

- HB550 and SB400 — House passage of HB550 on 2619971 is Yea. House passage of SB400 on 26110470 is Yea. Do not invent admissions-tax Nays.
- HB958 — The token on 26110137 is Yea, not A and not X. There is no A in this tax universe. X=0.
- Shared-refid blocks (26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, 2619915) — all six are Yea. Do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position. Do not copy a peer X onto 26110723.
- HISTORY join gaps: 46 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed. 26110458X is a trailing-X duplicate; unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29 as Yea. This paper does not invent a tax bill from that suffix row.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.

- Universe = H0349 token in VOTE.CSV joined to a bill that passes build_taxes.is_tax_bill (imported, not rewritten): keyword plus Title 58.1 summary plus forced budget vehicles (HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30/(HB | SB)600x), minus land-use-only data-center false positives. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. Budget vehicles and version votes sit in the same filter. There are 0 H02 Appropriations-prefixed and 0 H11 General Laws-prefixed vote_ids in this ledger. That join is why this ledger counts 110 events on 46 tax bills. This paper does not invent a reason beyond the CSV.

- 20262 is HB30 only: 13 events, all Yea (26211488 and 26211491 through 26211502). Other Special Session tax bills were not invented. There is no Special I X cluster in the scored tax universe. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I A.

- A token on a substitute is the recorded token on that action. HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881 are N on Senate substitute rejected by House. Those Nays are procedural/version. HB30 26110806 is N on Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). SB388 26110528 is N on Passed House with amendments (61-Y 37-N 0-A). SB661 26110685 is N on Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A). It is not X. SB661 26111306 is N on conference report rejected. SB661 26111310 is N on conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Conference-agreed N is still N. HB1279 26111245 is N on conference report agreed.
