Twelve Present/Not Voting (X) tokens sit under this KPI strip: 20262 votes 26211491 through 26211502 (HB30 Governor-recommendation Nos. 3-5, 1, 2, 6.1, 7-14). Combined: 111 events, 46 tax bills, 96 Yea, 3 Nay, 12 X, 0 P, 0 A. 20261 Regular: 98 events, 45 tax bills, 95 Yea, 3 Nay, 0 X. 20262 Special I: 13 events, 1 bill (HB30 only), 1 Yea plus 12 X. Regular session has 0 X. X is not Nay and is not absence. The Special I X cluster is twelve recorded Present/Not Voting tokens on 6/29/2026. It is not hidden.

Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Henson has 111 recorded vote events across 46 tax-related bills: 96 Yea, 3 Nay, and 12 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 98 events on 45 tax bills (95 Yea, 3 Nay, 0 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30: 1 Yea and 12 X. The Special I X cluster is twelve Governor-recommendation votes on 6/29/2026. It is not hidden. The one Special I Yea is 26211488, conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A). High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. High X is not absence and is not Nay. Regular session has 0 X.

The Regular-session record is one-sided on the Yea side. Henson supported 96 of 111 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The three Nays are three recorded actions in his H0365 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a fourth Nay. This paper does not invent SB661 Nays. The three SB661 events in this ledger are Yea: House passage with substitute on 3/3/2026 (26110685, 57-Y 39-N 1-A), conference report rejected by House on 3/14/2026 (26111306, 49-Y 44-N 3-A), and conference report agreed to by House on 3/14/2026 (26111310, 57-Y 38-N 1-A).

The three Nays, named and unflattened, are 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); and 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A). Votes 26110807 and 26110881 are N for this member. Peers may have X on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. The HB145 and HB1279 Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. HB1279 is one Nay, the Senate-substitute rejection. This CSV has no HB1279 subcommittee, committee, floor-passage, or conference Nay. Floor passage of HB1279 on 26110016 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111245 is Yea. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. This CSV has no SB661 committee event.

Twelve X tokens stay X. They are not flattened to N and they are not treated as absence. All twelve sit in 20262. Regular session has 0 X. The twelve are 26211491 through 26211502, House concurrences in Governor's recommendation Nos. 3, 4, and 5; 1; 2; 6.1; 7; 8; 9; 10; 11; 12; 13; and 14, all X. The one Special I Yea is 26211488. This paper does not flatten the 12 X into that Yea. 20262 unjoined 26211490 is X but unjoined. It is not scored as tax. The bill was not guessed. This paper does not invent Regular-session X rows. Vote 26110137 on HB958, Read third time and passed House (96-Y 1-N 1-A) on 2/10/2026, is Yea. That Yea is not A.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Henson uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 111 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. A high X count is not absence. The twelve Special I X tokens are recorded Present/Not Voting tokens on Governor-recommendation rolls. They are not missing votes and they are not Nays. The combined 111-event line is a smaller combined count than some peer ledgers because Special I contributes twelve Present/Not Voting tokens rather than twelve Yea tokens, and because this CSV has fewer committee joins. Regular-session 20261 is 98 events on 45 tax bills. That Regular count sits in the peer band of joined floor tokens. It is not a thin universe. This paper does not backfill unjoined *vote_ids*.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 111 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea, including 26110723. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 12 X, 0 P, and 0 A. All twelve X

tokens sit in Budget / Appropriations (the 20262 Governor-recommendation cluster). The three Nays sit in Sector/Excise Tax (HB145 26110807), Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881), and Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806). Regular session has 0 X.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Three Nays. Twelve X. Zero P. Zero A. The twelve X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The three Nays named below are Henson's H0365 CSV tokens. HB30 appears once as N. HB145 appears once as N. HB1279 appears once as N. Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a fourth Nay. This paper does not invent SB661 Nays. Henson recorded Yea on all three SB661 events in this ledger.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Henson's token is N. This is a version/vehicle vote on a forced budget vehicle, not a standalone tax-rate roll. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. It is N for this member. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Henson recorded Yea on the other 38 of 39 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A).

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). Henson's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Henson recorded Yea on House passage (89-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26110434, and Yea on the conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26111217. Those Yea tokens are not this Nay. This CSV has no HB145 committee event.

Nay: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. One recorded Nay on this bill, the Senate-substitute rejection:

Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A).

Henson's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. This is his only HB1279 Nay.

Vote 26110016 on 2/5/2026 is Yea: H Read third time and passed House (60-Y 36-N 0-A). Vote 26111245 on 3/14/2026 is Yea: H Conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A). Vote 26111389 on 4/22/2026 is Yea: H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A). Those Yea tokens are not this Nay. This CSV has no HB1279 subcommittee or committee event. This paper does not invent subcommittee, committee, floor-passage, or conference Nays on HB1279.

Analysis. Two of the three Nays are Senate-substitute rejections (HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881). Those are procedural/version events. One Nay is HB30 26110806, Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. They are not a tax-rate census. The twelve X tokens are not a fourth Nay. Henson has no SB661 Nays in this tax universe. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. Regular session has 0 X.

3. Present/Not Voting (X)

Documented Fact. Twelve Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. X is not N. X is not Y. X is not absence. Those twelve X tokens sit in his CSV. This paper does not invent additional X rows, and it does not copy a peer Y or N onto these events. Zero sit in 20261. Twelve sit in 20262. Regular session has 0 X. The Special I X cluster is the recorded story on the Governor-recommendation rolls. It is not hidden.

X: HB30 Special I Governor-recommendation cluster. Twelve recorded Present/Not Voting tokens on 6/29/2026. All twelve stay X. They are not Nays and they are not absences. The one Special I Yea among the 13 scored 20262 events is 26211488, conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A) on 6/22/2026. It is not one of these twelve. That Yea was read from this member's CSV. It was not copied from another member.

Date-clustered Not Voting in Special I is this named twelve-vote Governor-recommendation cluster plus the unjoined 26211490 row that is not scored here. Votes 26110807 and 26110881 are N, not X. Vote 26110806 is N, not X.

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. HJ34. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. Henson recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, H Agreed to by House (68-Y 25-N 0-A).

The House-passage token on SB388 26110528 is Yea. The conference token on 26111279 is Yea. The Governor's-recommendation token on 26111431 is Yea. This CSV has no SB388 committee event. HB400 26110809, Senate substitute agreed to by House (70-Y 24-N 0-A), is Yea. HB958 26110137 is Yea. That Yea is not A and is not X.

8. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30)

HB29 and HB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. Henson recorded Yea on all six 20261 HB29 events in this ledger, including House passage (63-Y 35-N 0-A) and Senate amendments agreed to by House (59-Y 35-N 0-A). The unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29. The trailing-X duplicate 26110458X is unjoined and is not scored as tax. This paper does not invent a bill for 26110458X.

On 20261 HB30 he recorded Yea on 38 events (committee amendments, floor amendments passed by, constitutional reading, and House passage 83-Y 14-N 0-A) and Nay on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That N is the unanimous rejection roll. It is a version/vehicle event. It is N for this member. Peers may have X on 26110806. This paper does not copy those tokens.

20262 is HB30 only: 13 events, 1 Yea and 12 X. Vote 26211488, conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A), is the one Special I Yea. That Yea was read from this member's CSV. The remaining twelve events are House concurrences in Governor's recommendations numbered 1 through 14, all X: 26211491, 26211492, 26211493, 26211494, 26211495, 26211496, 26211497, 26211498, 26211499, 26211500, 26211501, and 26211502. The Special I X cluster is those twelve tokens. It is not hidden. This paper does not flatten the 12 X into the 26211488 Yea. There is no Special I Nay. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). Henson supported 96 of 111 recorded tax-universe events. The three Nays are three recorded actions: one HB30 Senate-amendments rejection (26110806, House 0-Y 92-N 0-A), one HB145 Senate-substitute rejection (26110807, House 0-Y 93-N 0-A), and one HB1279 Senate-substitute rejection (26110881, House 0-Y 95-N 0-A). The two Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. House passage of SB661 with substitute on 26110685 is Yea, not Nay. Conference report rejected on 26111306 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111310 is Yea. This CSV has no SB661 committee event. This paper does not invent SB661 Nays. HB1279 floor passage on 26110016 is Yea. HB1279 conference on 26111245 is Yea. This CSV has no HB1279 subcommittee or committee event. SB388 has no Nay. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad Regular-session support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus, with a documented three-event version/vehicle Nay set and a Special I Present/Not Voting cluster on HB30 Governor-recommendation votes, than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Henson has twelve X tokens in this tax universe, zero Present (P) tokens, and zero Abstain (A) tokens. X is not Nay and is not absence. Regular session has 0 X. All twelve X tokens sit in Special I on HB30 Governor-recommendation Nos. 3-5, 1, 2, 6.1, and 7-14. The one Special I Yea is 26211488. This paper does not flatten those twelve X tokens

into that Yea. Shared-refid events 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915 are Yea, including 26110723. Vote 26110137 on HB958 (House passage, 96-Y 1-N 1-A) is Yea, not A.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Henson's Nay on 26110806, 26110807, and 26110881 where peers may have X, his Yea on all three SB661 events where peers may have Nay, his single HB1279 Nay on the Senate-substitute rejection rather than a subcommittee, committee, floor-passage, or conference cluster, his Yea on shared-refid 26110723 where some peers recorded X, and the twelve-vote Special I Governor-recommendation X cluster. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why he voted. This ledger is H0365 only.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 and HB1279 Senate substitutes versus the later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Senate-amendment text on 20261 HB30 26110806 is not lined to any single tax item. Governor-recommendation text on 20262 HB30 is not lined to any single tax item. Why twelve Special I Governor-recommendation tokens are X while 26211488 is Yea is not established by the vote file.

- HB1279 — Keep the one Nay as one recorded action (26110881 Senate substitute rejected, procedural/version). House passage on 26110016 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111245 is Yea. Governor's recommendation on 26111389 is Yea. Do not invent subcommittee, committee, floor-passage, or conference Nays. This CSV has no HB1279 subcommittee or committee event. Peers may have X on 26110881. Do not copy those tokens.
- SB388 — All three events are Yea (26110528 House passage with amendments; 26111279 conference report agreed; 26111431 Governor's recommendation). This CSV has no SB388 committee event. Do not invent a committee Nay.
- HB145 — Henson's token on the Senate-substitute rejection (0-Y 93-N 0-A), vote 26110807, is N. Procedural/version, not policy opposition. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. Do not copy those tokens. House passage on 26110434 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111217 (87-Y 8-N 0-A) is Yea, not X. This CSV has no HB145 committee event.
- HB30 Regular — Henson's token on the Senate-amendments rejection (0-Y 92-N 0-A), vote 26110806, is N. Version/vehicle, not a tax-rate roll. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. Do not copy those tokens. The other 38 Regular-session HB30 events are Yea.
- HB958 — The token on 26110137 is Yea, not A and not X. Do not invent an Abstain on House passage (96-Y 1-N 1-A).
- 20262 HB30 — The one Special I Yea is 26211488, conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A). The twelve Governor-recommendation votes 26211491 through 26211502 stay X. Do not flatten the 12 X into that Yea. Do not copy a peer Special I mix onto this CSV. Unjoined 26211490 is X but unjoined; it is not scored as tax.
- Shared-refid blocks (26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, 2619915) — all six are Yea, including 26110723. Do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position. Do not copy a peer X onto 26110723.
- HISTORY join gaps: 45 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed. 26110458X is a trailing-X duplicate; unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29. This paper does not invent a tax bill from that suffix row. Unjoined 26110815 and 26110830 are Y for this member and unjoined; they are not scored as tax. Unjoined Regular X tokens 26110888, 26111159, 26111161, and 26111209 are unjoined and are not scored as tax. Regular scored X remains 0.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.
