Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Keys-Gamarra has 188 recorded vote events across 62 tax-related bills: 174 Yea, 5 Nay, and 9 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 175 events on 61 tax bills (161 Yea, 5 Nay, 9 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. X is named in this body. It is not a cover KPI.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side. Keys-Gamarra supported 174 of 188 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax ideology label. High Yea is not an ideology label. The five Nays are her CSV tokens only. They are not copied from another member. Keys-Gamarra's Nay on 20261 vote H10002V2610609, HB1199, is a Finance subcommittee failure to recommend reporting (3-Y 7-N) on 1/27/2026. That venue is subcommittee. It is not a House-floor policy Nay. Keys-Gamarra's Nay on 20261 vote 26110806, HB30, is the House rejection of Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. Keys-Gamarra's Nay on 20261 vote 26110807, HB145, is the House rejection of a Senate substitute (0-Y 93-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. That event is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill titled Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Keys-Gamarra's Nay on 20261 vote 26110881, HB1279, is the House rejection of a Senate substitute (0-Y 95-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. That event is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill titled Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Keys-Gamarra's remaining Nay is 20261 vote 26111306, SB661, conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). That token is N. It is the only SB661 Nay in this ledger.

This paper does not invent a Nay on 26110685 or on 26111310. Keys-Gamarra's token on 26110685, SB661 House passage with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A), is Yea. Keys-Gamarra's token on 26111310, SB661 conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A), is Yea. Those two vote_ids are not Nays in her CSV. This paper does not copy another member's missing SB661 Nays onto H0370.

Keys-Gamarra recorded nine Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. Seven of those nine sit on 2/3/2026 (three House-floor events and four Finance subcommittee events). One X sits on 2/10/2026. One X sits on 2/26/2026. Date-clustered X on 2/3/2026 is treated as absence, not a subject pattern. This paper does not treat that cluster as a subject pattern unless a subject pattern is proven. X is not N. X is not Y. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay. Shared-refid 2619915 is X, not Y. The nine X events are named in section 3. They are not cover KPIs.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Keys-Gamarra uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 188 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. This universe is larger than a floor-only screen because Finance subcommittee vote_ids (H10002 prefix) are joined when they match HISTORY and pass the tax filter. Those subcommittee rolls are recorded events. They are not invented bills.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 188 events rather than splitting a single roll call. Shared-refid 2619915 is one of those six. Its token is X, not Y. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay. It is not Yea. Keys-Gamarra has 9 X, 0 P, and 0 A in this tax universe. The nine X tokens sit in several title-derived categories because seven of them share the 2/3/2026 date, not because this paper has proven a subject pattern.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Five Nays. Nine X. Zero P. Zero A. The nine X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The five Nays named below are Keys-Gamarra's CSV tokens. This paper does not add 26110685 or 26111310 as Nays.

Nay: HB1199 — Local license taxes; authority to exempt, businesses regulated by boards within DHP. Vote H10002V2610609 on 1/27/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee failed to recommend reporting (3-Y 7-N). Keys-Gamarra's token is N. The venue is Finance subcommittee. This is not a House-floor policy Nay. This paper does not treat a subcommittee failure-to-report as a floor policy position on the underlying bill. HB1199 has no other H0370 token in this tax universe.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Keys-Gamarra's token is N. It is not X. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. This is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle, not a standalone tax-rate roll. Keys-Gamarra's separate X on 26110571 (Item 352 #1h, 2/26/2026) is a different event. It is named in section 3.

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). Keys-Gamarra's token is N. It is not X. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on House passage (26110434, 89-Y 8-N 0-A) and Yea on the conference report agreed to by House (26111217, 87-Y 8-N 0-A). This paper does not copy another member's X onto 26111217. That vote_id is Y in this CSV.

Nay: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A). Keys-Gamarra's token is N. It is not X. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute

unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on the other four HB1279 events in this ledger (Counties, Cities and Towns report, House passage, conference report, Governor's recommendation).

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote 26111306 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). Keys-Gamarra's token is N. This is the only SB661 Nay in this ledger. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 26110685, House passage with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A), and Yea on 26111310, conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). This paper does not invent a Nay on 26110685 or on 26111310.

Analysis. The HB1199 Nay is a subcommittee venue, not a House-floor policy Nay. The HB145 and HB1279 Senate-substitute Nays and the HB30 Senate-amendments Nay are procedural/version events. The SB661 conference-rejected Nay is a recorded token on that action. They are not an ideology label, and they are not a tax-rate census. The nine X tokens are not a sixth through fourteenth Nay.

3. Present/Not Voting (X)

Documented Fact. Nine Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. X is not N. X is not Y. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay. Date-clustered X is treated as absence, not a subject pattern, unless a subject pattern is proven. This paper does not call the 2/3/2026 cluster a subject pattern.

Seven of the nine X tokens sit on 2/3/2026. Three are House-floor events. Four are Finance subcommittee events. The remaining two X tokens sit on other dates: 2/10/2026 (one Finance subcommittee event) and 2/26/2026 (one HB30 contested committee amendment). Those dates are named. They are not collapsed into the 2/3 cluster.

X on 2/3/2026, House floor.

- 2619915 on 2/3/2026. Bills HB163; HB488; HB716; HB960. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (98-Y 0-N 0-A). Token X. This is a shared-refid block. It is one KPI event. The token is X, not Y. This paper does not copy another member's Yea onto 2619915.
- 2619951 on 2/3/2026. HB854. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A). Token X. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on earlier HB854 subcommittee and Finance events and Yea on the later Senate substitute agreed to by House (26110865, 3/6/2026, 90-Y 5-N 0-A).
- 2619953 on 2/3/2026. HB474. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A). Token X. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on the earlier HB474 subcommittee and Finance events.

X on 2/3/2026, Finance subcommittee.

- H10002V2611582 on 2/3/2026. HB1358. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (10-Y 0-N). Token X. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea the next day on Finance report (H10V2611738, 2/4/2026) and Yea on the later shared-refid House passage 26110094 (2/10/2026).
- H10002V2611584 on 2/3/2026. HB557. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting (7-Y 3-N). Token X. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea the next day on Finance report (2/4/2026) and Yea on House passage (2/10/2026, 62-Y 35-N 0-A).
- H10002V2611585 on 2/3/2026. HB167. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting (7-Y 3-N). Token X. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea the next day on Finance report (2/4/2026) and Yea on House passage (2/10/2026, 62-Y 35-N 0-A).
- H10002V2611587 on 2/3/2026. HB915. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (10-Y 0-N). Token X. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea the next day on Finance report (2/4/2026) and Yea on House passage (2/10/2026, 68-Y 30-N 0-A).

Those seven 2/3/2026 X tokens share a date. They do not share a single subject. Several of the same bills have Yea on 2/4/2026 or 2/10/2026. That sequence is the reason this paper treats the 2/3 cluster as absence rather than a subject pattern. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay.

X on 2/10/2026. H10002V2612619, HB919, Finance subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (5-Y 4-N). Token X. This is not a 2/3 event. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on a different HB919 subcommittee roll the same day (H10002V2612603, 7-Y 2-N) and Yea on the Finance report the next day (H10V2612760, 2/11/2026, 14-Y 7-N). The 2/10 X is one subcommittee roll. It is not a day-long absence.

X on 2/26/2026. 26110571, HB30, contested committee amendment Item 352 #1h agreed to (63-Y 33-N 0-A). Token X. This is not a 2/3 event. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on the surrounding 2/26 HB30 contested amendments, including Item 352 #3h (26110572, 66-Y 31-N 0-A) and House passage (26110593, 83-Y 14-N 0-A). The 2/26 X is one amendment roll. It is not a day-long absence. It is not the HB30 Senate-amendments Nay on 26110806.

There are 0 Present (P) and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. X is Present/Not Voting. It is not absence as a token label, but the 2/3 date cluster is interpreted as absence from those rolls rather than as a subject pattern. X is not N. X is not Y.

4. Real & Personal Property Tax

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Shared-refid property titles that also have a concatenated floor event (HB1358, SB649, HB960) keep their standalone committee events here. The concatenated floor rolls are listed once in section 7 so a single roll call is not narrated twice as two positions.

HB282. Real property tax; classification of land and improvement in Cities of Charlottesville/Falls Church. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 1/20/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (9-Y 1-N); Yea on 1/21/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (21-Y 1-N); Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (91-Y 8-N 0-A).

HB854. Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (8-Y 1-N); Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (9-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/28/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (22-Y 0-N); Present/Not Voting (X) on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (90-Y 5-N 0-A).

HB474. Real estate with delinquent taxes or liens; apptmt. of special commissioner, increases value. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (10-Y 0-N); Yea on 1/28/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (22-Y 0-N); Present/Not Voting (X) on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (11-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (17-Y 4-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with substitute (70-Y 29-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (65-Y 31-N 0-A).

HB566. Tangible personal property tax relief; rate of taxation. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N).

SB649. Real property tax; special assessment on basis of use, notice requirements. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on 2/18/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (21-Y 0-N).

8. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30)

HB29 and HB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on all six 20261 HB29 events in this ledger, including House passage (63-Y 35-N 0-A) and Senate amendments agreed to by House (59-Y 35-N 0-A).

On 20261 HB30 she recorded 39 events: 37 Yea, 1 X, and 1 Nay. The X is 26110571 on 2/26/2026, contested committee amendment Item 352 #1h agreed to (63-Y 33-N 0-A). That token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. She recorded Yea on House passage (26110593, 83-Y 14-N 0-A) and Nay on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That N is the unanimous rejection roll. It is not X.

20262 is HB30 only: 13 Yea events, including the conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A) and House concurrences in Governor's recommendations numbered 1 through 14. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). Keys-Gamarra supported 174 of 188 recorded tax-universe events. The five Nays are her CSV tokens: one Finance subcommittee failure to recommend reporting on HB1199 (H10002V2610609, 3-Y 7-N), one HB30 Senate-amendments rejection (26110806, House 0-Y 92-N 0-A), one HB145 Senate-substitute rejection (26110807, House 0-Y 93-N 0-A), one HB1279 Senate-substitute rejection (26110881, House 0-Y 95-N 0-A), and one SB661 conference report rejected by House (26111306, 49-Y 44-N 3-A). HB1199 is subcommittee venue, not a House-floor policy Nay. The HB145 and HB1279 Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. Keys-Gamarra recorded Yea on SB661 House passage with substitute (26110685) and Yea on SB661 conference report agreed (26111310). Those two vote_ids are not Nays in this ledger.

The nine X tokens are not Nays. Seven sit on 2/3/2026 across House-floor and Finance subcommittee rolls. That date cluster is treated as absence, not a subject pattern. Several of the same bills have Yea on 2/4/2026 or 2/10/2026, which is the recorded sequence that undercuts a subject reading. The 2/10 HB919 subcommittee X sits next to a same-day HB919 subcommittee Yea and a next-day Finance Yea, so it is not a day-long absence. The 2/26 HB30 Item 352 #1h X sits among Yea tokens on the surrounding contested amendments and on House passage, so it is not a day-long absence. Shared-refid 2619915 is X, not Y. X is not N. X is not Y. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay.

Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, subcommittee rolls, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture. High Yea is not an ideology label.

Comparative significance. The scarcity of floor policy Nays means differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — not in Keys-Gamarra's Yea rate. Finance subcommittee rolls enlarge this denominator relative to a floor-only screen. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 Senate substitute (Nay on 26110807) versus the conference report (Yea on 26111217), the HB1279 Senate substitute versus the conference report, the SB661 conference-rejected vehicle versus the later conference-agreed vehicle (Yea on 26111310), and the HB30 Senate amendments versus the House-passed vehicle, is not compared in this paper. The reason for the 2/3/2026 X cluster is not in the CSV. Governor-recommendation text on 20262 HB30 is not lined to any single tax item.

10. Priority Follow-Up Research

- HB1199 — Keep H10002V2610609 as a subcommittee Nay (3-Y 7-N). Do not treat it as a House-floor policy Nay. Confirm whether the bill returned in any later venue; this CSV has no second H0370 token on HB1199.
- SB661 — Keys-Gamarra's tokens are Yea on 26110685, Nay on 26111306, and Yea on 26111310. Do not invent a Nay on 26110685 or on 26111310. Compare the conference-rejected report with the conference-agreed report.
- HB30 — Keys-Gamarra's token on the Senate-amendments rejection (0-Y 92-N 0-A) is N, not X. Keys-Gamarra's token on Item 352 #1h (26110571) is X, not N. Do not flatten those two events. Do not copy another member's X onto 26110584; that vote_id is Y in this CSV.
- HB145 — Keys-Gamarra's token on the Senate-substitute rejection (0-Y 93-N 0-A) is N, not X. Procedural/ version, not policy opposition. Keys-Gamarra's token on the conference report agreed (87-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26111217, is Y, not X. Do not copy another member's X onto 26111217.
- HB1279 — Keys-Gamarra's token on 26110881 is N, not X. Compare the House bill, the Senate substitute rejected 0-Y 95-N 0-A, the conference report (54-Y 41-N 0-A), and the Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A) before assigning substantive meaning to the procedural Nay.
- 2/3/2026 X cluster — seven events (2619915, 2619951, 2619953, H10002V2611582, H10002V2611584, H10002V2611585, H10002V2611587). Treat as absence, not a subject pattern, unless a subject pattern is proven. Shared-refid 2619915 is X, not Y.
- Shared-refid blocks (26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, 2619915) — do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position. HB1529 appears only in 26110289.
- HISTORY join gaps: 52 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.

- Subject lock: official LIS member ID H0370, name token Karen Keys-Gamarra. House District 7 | HD-7 | Fairfax (part) | Democrat is the task identity for this product. Members.csv columns on disk are MBR_HOU, MBR_MBRNO, and MBR_NAME only; they do not print party or district. Official member page: <https://house.vga.virginia.gov/members/H0370>
- Universe = H0370 token in VOTE.CSV joined to a bill that passes build_taxes.is_tax_bill (imported, not rewritten): keyword plus Title 58.1 summary plus forced budget vehicles (HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30/(HB | SB)600x), minus land-use-only data-center false positives. High Yea is not an ideology label. Budget vehicles and version votes sit in the same filter.
- Join: vote_id.strip() == History_refid.strip(). Unique events are counted as (session, vote_id). CSV rows = 188 (20261 = 175, 20262 = 13). Token mix: Y=174, N=5, X=9, P=0, A=0. Unique tax bills with at least one H0370 token: 62 (20261 = 61, 20262 = 1). 20261 and 20262 are not collapsed in the appendix.
- The Martinez first-pass paper screen of 34/26/33/1 is a different denominator. This ledger was not forced to look like that screen.
- 2025 files and va-member-votes-wide.csv were not used.
- HISTORY join gaps: 52 unjoined unique 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined unique 20262 vote_ids cannot be assigned a bill and were not scored as tax. Bills were not invented for those IDs. One unjoined ID is a VOTE.CSV duplicate row with a trailing X on the vote_id (26110458X); the unsuffixed 26110458 does join to HB29 and is not copied onto the suffix row. One unjoined ID is a VOTE.CSV duplicate row with a trailing X on the vote_id (H07V2613148X); the unsuffixed H07V2613148 does join to HB1238 (Counties, Cities and Towns report; not in this tax universe) and is not copied onto the suffix row. 20262 vote_id 26211458 is a live VOTE.CSV row with no History_refid; the bill is not guessed.

- Six shared-refid events concatenate multiple tax bills with “;” and remain one KPI event and one ledger row: 2619915 HB163;HB488;HB716;HB960 (token X, not Y); 26110094 HB1180;HB1358 (Y); 26110289 HB954;HB1008;HB1529 (Y); 26110461 SB316;SB591;SB649 (Y); 26110723 SB660;SB779 (Y); 26110724 SB660;SB779 (Y).
- 20262 is HB30 only, 13 Yea. Other Special Session tax bills were not invented.
- A Nay on a substitute is not automatically opposition to the underlying bill. HB1199 H10002V2610609 is N on a subcommittee failure to recommend reporting, not a House-floor policy Nay. HB30 26110806 is N on Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A), not X. HB145 26110807 is N on the Senate-substitute rejection, not X. HB1279 26110881 is N on the Senate-substitute rejection, not X. SB661 26111306 is N on the conference report rejected by House. SB661 26110685 and 26111310 are Yea in this CSV; those vote_ids are not Nays. HB145 26111217 is Yea on the conference report agreed to by House; that token is not X.
- Keys-Gamarra has nine X tokens in this tax universe. Seven sit on 2/3/2026. Date-clustered X is treated as absence, not a subject pattern. X is not Nay and not Yea. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay. There are 0 P and 0 A.
- Category labels are title-derived. Residual Tax Administration / Other is used when a title does not clearly fit a Martinez bucket, including the six mixed shared-refid events and SB224. Counts sum to 188. Dollars were not invented.
- Four-tier labels used in the body: Documented Fact, Reported Claim, Analysis, Open Question. The vote ledger is behavior, not motive.
- Source of record: official 20261 and 20262 Virginia LIS session files (VOTE.CSV, BILLS.CSV, HISTORY.CSV, Summaries.csv, Members.csv) joined to H0370. This file is a client-format intelligence paper. It is not a public posting.
