Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Krizek has 126 recorded vote events across 48 tax-related bills: 119 Yea, 5 Nay, and 2 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 113 events on 47 tax bills (106 Yea, 5 Nay, 2 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X in the scored tax universe. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side. Krizek supported 119 of 126 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The five Nays are five recorded actions in his H0281 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a sixth Nay. The five Nays, named and unflattened, are H11V2613579 on SB661 (Reported from General Laws with substitute, 14-Y 6-N); H11V2613582 on SB661 (Reported from General Laws with substitute, 11-Y 9-N); 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A); 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A); and 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A). Votes 26110807 and 26110881 are N for this member. Peers may have X on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. The HB145 and HB1279 Nays are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The two SB661 Nays are General Laws committee recorded actions. They are not conference Nays.

The remaining SB661 events in this ledger are Yea. Vote 26110685 on 3/3/2026, Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A), is Yea. Vote 26111306 on 3/14/2026, Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A), is Yea. Vote 26111310 on 3/14/2026, Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A), is Yea. Those conference tokens were read from HISTORY.CSV and from this member's H0281 row in VOTE.CSV. They are Yea. This paper does not invent conference Nays on SB661. Peers may have N on 26111306 and 26111310. This paper does not copy those tokens.

The two X tokens stay X. They are not Nays. They are not absences. Both sit on HB145. Vote H11003V2610565 on 1/27/2026, Subcommittee recommends reporting and referring to Appropriations (9-Y 0-N), is X. Vote 26111217 on 3/14/2026, Conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A), is X. The Senate-substitute Nay on HB145 26110807 is a different event. This paper does not flatten the X conference token into that Nay. X is not Nay and is not Yea.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Krizek uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Sixty of the 126 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 126 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea, including 26110723. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 2 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The five Nays sit in Sector/Excise Tax (two SB661 committee actions and HB145 26110807), Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881), and Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806). The two X sit in Sector/Excise Tax (both HB145: H11003V2610565 and 26111217).

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Five Nays. Two X. Zero P. Zero A. The two X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The five Nays named below are Krizek's H0281 CSV tokens. Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a sixth Nay. This paper does not invent SB661 conference Nays. Krizek recorded Yea on House passage of SB661 with substitute and Yea on both SB661 conference actions.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Two recorded committee Nays on the same bill, not one Nay flattened:

Vote H11V2613579 on 2/24/2026. Official recorded action: H Reported from General Laws with substitute (14-Y 6-N). Krizek's token is N. This is a committee Nay.

Vote H11V2613582 on 2/24/2026. Official recorded action: H Reported from General Laws with substitute (11-Y 9-N). Krizek's token is N. This is a committee Nay. HISTORY records a reconsideration between those two reports. They remain two recorded actions.

Vote 26110685 on 3/3/2026 is Yea: H Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A). Vote 26111306 on 3/14/2026 is Yea: H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). Vote 26111310 on 3/14/2026 is Yea: H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Those Yea tokens are not these Nays. This paper does not invent conference Nays or a passage Nay on SB661.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Krizek's token is N. This is a version/vehicle vote on a forced budget vehicle, not a standalone tax-rate roll. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. It is N for this member. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Krizek recorded Yea on the other 39 of 40 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A).

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). Krizek's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. The HB145 conference token on 26111217 is X, named in section 3. It is not this Nay.

Nay: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A). Krizek's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. Krizek recorded Yea on House passage (60-Y 36-N 0-A), vote 26110016; Yea on the conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A), vote 26111245; and Yea on House concurrence in the Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A), vote 26111389. Those Yea tokens are not this Nay.

Analysis. Two of the five Nays are Senate-substitute rejections (HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881). Those are procedural/version events. One Nay is HB30 26110806, Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. Two Nays are SB661 General Laws committee reports (H11V2613579 and H11V2613582). They are not a tax-rate census. They are not conference Nays. The two X tokens are not a sixth Nay.

3. Present/Not Voting (X)

Documented Fact. Two Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. X is not N. X is not Y. X is not absence. Those two X tokens sit in his CSV. This paper does not invent additional X rows, and it does not copy a peer Y or N onto these events. Both sit in 20261 on HB145. There is no Special I X in the scored tax universe.

Krizek recorded Yea on the General Laws report and referral to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N), vote H11V2610929; Yea on the Appropriations subcommittee recommendation (7-Y 0-N), vote H02001V2612768; Yea on the Appropriations report (22-Y 0-N), vote H02V2612879; and Yea on House passage (89-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26110434. Those Yea tokens are not this X.

X: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26111217 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A). Krizek's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. He is not in the 87 and not in the 8. This conference X is not the Senate-substitute Nay on 26110807. Those are different recorded actions. This paper does not flatten 26111217 into Nay.

There are 0 Present (P) and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. 20262 unjoined 26211490 is Y, not X, and unjoined; it is not scored as a Special I tax event. Date-clustered Not Voting is not present as a Special I X cluster in this scored file. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write a Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member.

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Shared-refid property titles (HB1358, SB649, HB960) are listed once in section 7 with their block events so a single roll call is not narrated twice. HJ34. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. Krizek recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, H Agreed to by House (68-Y 25-N 0-A).

The conference token on SB388 26111279 is Yea. HB400 26110809, Senate substitute agreed to by House (70-Y 24-N 0-A), is Yea.

HB958. Income tax, corporate; taxable income, net operating loss. Krizek recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (96-Y 1-N 1-A).

SB612. Motion picture production; extends income tax credit sunset. Krizek recorded Yea on 2/23/2026, H Passed House (74-Y 23-N 0-A).

Peers may have X on 26110723. This paper does not copy those tokens. Krizek is Y.

8. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30)

HB29 and HB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. Krizek recorded Yea on all seven 20261 HB29 events in this ledger, including the Appropriations report with amendment(s) (15-Y 7-N), House passage (63-Y 35-N 0-A), and Senate amendments agreed to by House (59-Y 35-N 0-A). The unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29. The trailing-X duplicate 26110458X is unjoined and is not scored as tax.

On 20261 HB30 he recorded Yea on 39 events (Appropriations report, committee amendments, floor amendments passed by, constitutional reading, and House passage 83-Y 14-N 0-A) and Nay on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That N is the unanimous rejection roll. It is a version/vehicle event. It is N for this member. Peers may have X on 26110806. This paper does not copy those tokens.

20262 is HB30 only: 13 events, all Yea. Vote 26211488, conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A), is Yea. The remaining twelve events are House concurrences in Governor's recommendations numbered 1 through 14, all Yea: 26211491, 26211492, 26211493, 26211494, 26211495, 26211496, 26211497, 26211498, 26211499, 26211500, 26211501, and 26211502. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X in the scored tax universe. This paper does not write a Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). Krizek supported 119 of 126 recorded tax-universe events. The five Nays are five recorded actions: two SB661 General Laws committee Nays (H11V2613579, 14-Y 6-N; H11V2613582, 11-Y 9-N), one HB30 Senate-amendments rejection (26110806, House 0-Y 92-N 0-A), one HB145 Senate-substitute rejection (26110807, House 0-Y 93-N 0-A), and one HB1279 Senate-substitute rejection (26110881, House 0-Y 95-N 0-A). The two Senate-substitute Nays are procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The two SB661 Nays are committee recorded actions. House passage of SB661 with substitute on 26110685 is Yea. Conference report rejected on 26111306 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111310 is Yea. This paper does not invent conference Nays. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Krizek has two X tokens in this tax universe and zero Present (P) and zero Abstain (A) tokens. X is not Nay and is not absence. The two X are H11003V2610565 on HB145 (subcommittee recommendation) and 26111217 on HB145 (conference report agreed to by House, 87-Y 8-N 0-A). The Senate-substitute Nay on HB145 26110807 is a different event. There is no Special I X cluster in the scored tax universe. Special I is 13 Yea on HB30. Shared-refid events 26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915 are Yea, including 26110723.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Krizek's Nay on 26110806, 26110807, and 26110881 where peers may have X, his two SB661 committee Nays where the later passage and conference tokens are Yea, his X on HB145 conference 26111217, and his Yea on shared-refid 26110723 where some peers recorded X. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why he voted. This ledger is H0281 only.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 and HB1279 Senate substitutes versus the later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Committee-substitute text on the two SB661 General Laws reports is not lined in this paper. Conference-report text on SB661 26111306 and 26111310 is not lined in this paper. Senate-amendment text on 20261 HB30 26110806 is not lined to any single tax item. Governor-recommendation text on 20262 HB30 is not lined to any single tax item. Why the HB145 conference token on 26111217 is X while House passage on 26110434 is Yea is not established by the vote file.

Conference report rejected on 26111306 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111310 is Yea. Do not flatten the two committee Nays into one Nay. Do not invent conference Nays or a passage Nay. Do not invent a sixth Nay.
- HB145 — Krizek's token on the Senate-substitute rejection (0-Y 93-N 0-A), vote 26110807, is N. Procedural/version, not policy opposition. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. Do not copy those tokens. The subcommittee token on H11003V2610565 is X. The conference token on 26111217 (87-Y 8-N 0-A) is X, not N and not Y. Do not flatten that conference X into the Senate-substitute Nay. House passage on 26110434 is Yea.
- HB1279 — The Senate-substitute Nay on 26110881 (0-Y 95-N 0-A) is procedural/version. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. Do not copy those tokens. House passage on 26110016 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111245 is Yea. Governor's recommendation on 26111389 is Yea. Do not flatten those four recorded actions.
- HB30 Regular — Krizek's token on the Senate-amendments rejection (0-Y 92-N 0-A), vote 26110806, is N. Version/vehicle, not a tax-rate roll. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. Do not copy those tokens. The other 39 Regular-session HB30 events are Yea.
- 20262 HB30 — All 13 scored Special I events are Yea, including 26211488 conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A) and Governor-recommendation votes 26211491 through 26211502. There is no Special I X cluster in the scored tax universe. This paper does not write a 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. Unjoined 26211490 is Y, not X, and unjoined; it is not scored as tax.
- Shared-refid blocks (26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, 2619915) — all six are Yea, including 26110723. Do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position. Do not copy a peer X onto 26110723.
- HISTORY join gaps: 49 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed. 26110458X is a trailing-X duplicate; unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29. Unjoined 26110815 and 26110830 are Y for this member and unjoined; they are not scored as tax.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.

- A token on a substitute is the recorded token on that action. HB145 26110807 and HB1279 26110881 are N on Senate substitute rejected by House. Those Nays are procedural/version. HB30 26110806 is N on Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). Krizek's five Nays are H11V2613579, H11V2613582, 26110806, 26110807, and 26110881 only. - Four-tier labels used in the body: Documented Fact, Reported Claim, Analysis, Open Question. The vote ledger is behavior, not motive.
