Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — McClure has 118 recorded vote events across 49 tax-related bills: 112 Yea and 6 Nay. There are no Present/Not Voting (X), no Present (P), and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 105 events on 48 tax bills (99 Yea, 6 Nay, 0 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side. McClure supported 112 of 118 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax ideology label. The six Nays are version, vehicle, and conference events, not a rate census. McClure's Nay on 20261 vote 26110806, HB30, is the House rejection of Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. McClure's Nay on 20261 vote 26110807, HB145, is the House rejection of a Senate substitute (0-Y 93-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. That event is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill titled Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. McClure's Nay on 20261 vote 26110881, HB1279, is the House rejection of a Senate substitute (0-Y 95-N 0-A). That event is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill titled Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. McClure's Nay on 20261 vote 26111279, SB388, is the conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A). A conference-agreed N is still N on that recorded action. The official title is Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. That Nay is not flattened with HB1279. McClure's two Nays on SB661, titled Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines, are conference events: vote 26111306, conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A), and vote 26111310, conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). A conference-agreed N is still N on that recorded action. McClure recorded Yea on 20261 vote 26110685, House passage with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A). That event is not a Nay. This paper does not invent a passage-with-substitute Nay that is not in her CSV.

McClure has zero tax-universe X tokens. This paper does not invent X rows and does not copy another member's Present/Not Voting card onto McClure.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean McClure uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-eight of the 118 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 118 events rather than splitting a single roll call. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. McClure has 0 X, 0 P, and 0 A in this tax universe.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Six Nays. Zero X. Zero P. Zero A.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). McClure's token is N. It is not X. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. This is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle, not a standalone tax-rate roll.

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). McClure's token is N. It is not X. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. McClure recorded Yea on the other HB145 events in this ledger (committee report, House passage, and conference report).

Nay: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A). This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. McClure recorded Yea on the other three HB1279 events in this ledger (House passage, conference report, Governor's recommendation).

Nay: SB388 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26111279 on 3/14/2026. Official recorded action: H Conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A). A conference-agreed N is still N on that recorded action. The title is the official LIS short title from her CSV. This Nay is not flattened with HB1279 or with any other bill. McClure recorded Yea on House passage with amendments (61-Y 37-N 0-A) and Yea on House concurrence in the Governor's recommendation (62-Y 36-N 0-A).

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Two recorded Nays on the same bill, not one Nay flattened:

- 26111306 on 3/14/2026. H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). Token N.
- 26111310 on 3/14/2026. H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Token N. A conference-agreed N is still N on that recorded action.

McClure recorded Yea on 26110685, House passage with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A), and Yea on the two General Laws committee reports in this ledger. Vote 26110685 is not a Nay. This paper does not invent a passage-with-substitute Nay that is not in her CSV.

Analysis. Senate-substitute Nays and the HB30 Senate-amendments Nay are procedural/version events. The SB388 and SB661 conference Nays are recorded tokens on those actions. They are not an ideology label, and they are not a tax-rate census.

Zero X. McClure has no Present/Not Voting (X) token in this tax universe. There are 0 P and 0 A. Date-clustered Not Voting is not present in this file.

3. Real & Personal Property Tax

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Shared-refid property titles (HB1358, SB649, HB960) are listed once in section 6 with their block events so a single roll call is not narrated twice.

HB175. Real property; tax exemption, surviving spouses of members of Armed Forces who died in line of duty. McClure recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (99-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB282. Real property tax; classification of land and improvement in Cities of Charlottesville/Falls Church. McClure recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (91-Y 8-N 0-A).

HB854. Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. McClure recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (90-Y 5-N 0-A).

HB474. Real estate with delinquent taxes or liens; apptmt. of special commissioner, increases value. McClure recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. McClure recorded Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with substitute (70-Y 29-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (65-Y 31-N 0-A).

HB557. Tangible personal property tax; establishes classification for electric landscaping equipment. McClure recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

HJ34. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. McClure recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, H Agreed to by House (68-Y 25-N 0-A).

HB1205. Motor vehicles insurance; hwy. use fee, tangible personal property tax relief for certain vehicles. McClure recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N).

HB1281. Motor vehicle insurance; highway use fee, and tangible personal property tax relief. McClure recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (7-Y 3-N).

4. Income Tax, Credits & Exemptions

HB400. Motion picture production; increases aggregate cap on tax credit, extends sunset. McClure recorded Yea on 2/17/2026, H Read third time and passed House (74-Y 23-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (70-Y 24-N 0-A).

HB167. Tax exemptions; Confederacy organizations. McClure recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

HB1279. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. McClure recorded Yea on 2/5/2026, H Read third time and passed House (60-Y 36-N 0-A); Nay on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A).

SB388. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. McClure recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Passed House with amendments (61-Y 37-N 0-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 36-N 0-A).

5. Sales, Use & Local Taxation

HB334. Additional local sales and use tax to support schools; referendum. McClure recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (70-Y 28-N 0-A).

HB897. Retail Sales and Use Tax; exemption for data centers, delayed effective date. McClure recorded Yea on 2/17/2026, H Read third time and passed House (61-Y 34-N 0-A).

HB550. Admissions tax in counties; retail sales and use tax dedicated to promotion of tourism. McClure recorded Yea on 2/4/2026, H Read third time and passed House (60-Y 37-N 0-A).

SB400. Admissions tax in counties; retail sales and use tax dedicated to promotion of tourism. McClure recorded Yea on 2/23/2026, H Passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

HB341. Plastic bag tax; distribution to towns. McClure recorded Yea on 1/27/2026, H Read third time and passed House (67-Y 32-N 0-A).

HB915. Local taxation; tax extension for federal government shutdown. McClure recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (68-Y 30-N 0-A).

HB524. Tourism improvement districts; transient occupancy tax in Arlington County. McClure recorded Yea on 2/17/2026, H Read third time and passed House (68-Y 28-N 0-A).

SB314. Tourism improvement districts; transient occupancy tax in Arlington County. McClure recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Passed House (67-Y 30-N 0-A).

6. Business, Excise & Tax Administration

HB145. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. McClure recorded Yea on 1/29/2026, H Reported from General Laws and referred to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/17/2026, H Read third time and passed House (89-Y 8-N 0-A); Nay on 3/4/2026, H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A).

SB129. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. McClure recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Reported from General Laws with substitute and referred to Appropriations (20-Y 0-N); Yea on 3/4/2026, H Passed House with substitute (91-Y 7-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (88-Y 7-N 0-A).

SB788. Alcoholic beverage control; payment of excise tax on beer, wine coolers, and wine, penalties. McClure recorded Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with amendments (91-Y 6-N 1-A).

SB302. Peanuts; excise tax, sunset extended. McClure recorded Yea on 3/5/2026, H Passed House with substitute (95-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB661. Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. McClure recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Reported from General Laws with substitute (14-Y 6-N); Yea on 2/24/2026, H Reported from General Laws with substitute (11-Y 9-N); Yea on 3/3/2026, H Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A).

HB1100. Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. McClure recorded Yea on 2/10/2026, H Read third time and passed House (85-Y 13-N 0-A); Yea on 3/10/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (78-Y 19-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (73-Y 25-N 0-A).

SB597. Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. McClure recorded Yea on 2/23/2026, H Passed House (83-Y 14-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (76-Y 20-N 0-A).

HB1142. Deferred or installment payment agreements; outstanding court-assessed fines, fees, taxes, or costs. McClure recorded Yea on 2/6/2026, H Reported from Public Safety with substitute and referred to Appropriations (22-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/13/2026, H Read third time and passed House (96-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB954. Rounding procedures; taxes and fees calculated, report. McClure recorded Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB1129. Local motor vehicle license & registration; failure to pay certain taxes, fees, & parking citations. McClure recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, H Subcommittee recommends laying on the table (8-Y 2-N).

Shared-refid block events

Six unique vote_ids attach to more than one tax bill. Each is one KPI event. Titles are concatenated in the CSV with a semicolon-space joiner. Bills are not invented, and the block is not flattened into one bill's ideology.

Yea on 20261 2619915 (2/3/2026): HB163; HB488; HB716; HB960 — Notarization, filing, & recordation of certain land records; duties of notary or settlement agent.; Wage garnishment; state tax debt.; Income tax, state; innocent spouse tax relief.; Personal property taxes; valuation, effective clause. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (98-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110094 (2/10/2026): HB1180; HB1358 — Income tax, state; free tax filing program for individuals.; Real property tax; special assessment on basis of use, notice requirements. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (98-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110289 (2/17/2026): HB954; HB1008; HB1529 — Rounding procedures; taxes and fees calculated, report.; Motor vehicle sales and use tax; exemption for electric vehicles, etc.; Tax Commissioner; information sharing, eligibility for medical assistance. Official recorded action: H Read third time and passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110461 (2/23/2026): SB316; SB591; SB649 — Notarization, filing, & recordation of certain land records; duties of notary or settlement agent.; Income tax, state; free tax filing program for individuals.; Real property tax; special assessment on basis of use, notice requirements. Official recorded action: H Passed House with substitute (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110723 (3/4/2026): SB660; SB779 — Virginia Self-Service Storage Act; disposal of abandoned personal property in certain cases.; Eminent domain; condemnation proceedings, entry of order and recordation of certificate. Official recorded action: H Passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110724 (3/4/2026): SB660; SB779 — Virginia Self-Service Storage Act; disposal of abandoned personal property in certain cases.; Eminent domain; condemnation proceedings, entry of order and recordation of certificate. Official recorded action: H Passed House (99-Y 0-N 0-A).

7. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30)

HB29 and HB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. McClure recorded Yea on all six 20261 HB29 events in this ledger, including House passage (63-Y 35-N 0-A) and Senate amendments agreed to by House (59-Y 35-N 0-A).

On 20261 HB30 she recorded Yea on 38 events (committee amendments, floor amendments passed by, constitutional reading, and House passage 83-Y 14-N 0-A) and Nay on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That N is the unanimous rejection roll. It is not X.

20262 is HB30 only: 13 Yea events, including the conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A) and House concurrences in Governor's recommendations numbered 1 through 14. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

8. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). McClure supported 112 of 118 recorded tax-universe events. The six Nays are version, vehicle, and conference actions: one HB30 Senate-amendments rejection (House 0-Y 92-N 0-A), one HB145 Senate-substitute rejection (House 0-Y 93-N 0-A), one HB1279 Senate-substitute rejection (House 0-Y 95-N 0-A), one SB388 conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A), one SB661 conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A), and one SB661 conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

McClure has zero X tokens in this tax universe. There are 0 Present (P) and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Date-clustered Not Voting is not an issue in this file.

Comparative significance. The scarcity of floor policy Nays means differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — not in McClure's Yea rate. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 and HB1279 Senate substitutes versus the conference reports, the SB388 House-amended vehicle versus the conference report, the SB661 House substitute (Yea on 26110685) versus the later conference vehicles (two Nays), and the HB30 Senate amendments versus the House-passed vehicle, is not compared in this paper. Governor-recommendation text on 20262 HB30 is not lined to any single tax item.

9. Priority Follow-Up Research

- HB30 — McClure's token on the Senate-amendments rejection (0-Y 92-N 0-A) is N, not X. Do not copy another member's X on this HISTORY sentence.
- HB145 — McClure's token on the Senate-substitute rejection (0-Y 93-N 0-A) is N, not X. Procedural/version, not policy opposition. Compare the House bill, the rejected Senate substitute, and the conference report (87-Y 8-N 0-A).
- HB1279 — Compare the House bill, the Senate substitute rejected 0-Y 95-N 0-A, the conference report (54-Y 41-N 0-A), and the Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A) before assigning substantive meaning to the procedural Nay.
- SB388 — McClure's Nay is the 3/14/2026 conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A). A conference-agreed N is still N. Do not flatten this Nay with HB1279. Compare the House-amended vehicle, the conference report, and the Governor's recommendation (62-Y 36-N 0-A).

- SB661 — Keep the two conference Nays as two recorded actions (conference rejected 26111306, conference agreed 26111310). McClure’s token on 26110685 House passage with substitute is Yea, not Nay. Do not copy another member’s Nay on that HISTORY sentence. Compare versions. Do not flatten a later Nay into the Yea or call the Nays an ideology label.
- Shared-refid blocks (26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, 2619915) — do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position.
- HISTORY join gaps: 46 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.

Members.csv columns on disk are MBR_HOU, MBR_MBRNO, and MBR_NAME only; they do not print party or district. Official member page: <https://house.vga.virginia.gov/members/H0375>
- Universe = H0375 token in VOTE.CSV joined to a bill that passes build_taxes.is_tax_bill (imported, not rewritten): keyword plus Title 58.1 summary plus forced budget vehicles (HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30/(HB | SB)600x), minus land-use-only data-center false positives. High Yea is not an ideology label. Budget vehicles and version votes sit in the same filter.
- Join: vote_id.strip() == History_refid.strip(). Unique events are counted as (session, vote_id). CSV rows = 118 (20261 = 105, 20262 = 13). Token mix: Y=112, N=6, X=0, P=0, A=0. Unique tax bills with at least one H0375 token: 49 (20261 = 48, 20262 = 1). 20261 and 20262 are not collapsed in the appendix.
- The Martinez first-pass paper screen of 34/26/33/1 is a different denominator. This ledger was not forced to look like that screen.
- 2025 files and va-member-votes-wide.csv were not used.
- HISTORY join gaps: 46 unjoined unique 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined unique 20262 vote_ids cannot be assigned a bill and were not scored as tax. Bills were not invented for those IDs. One unjoined ID is a VOTE.CSV duplicate row with a trailing X on the vote_id (26110458X); the unsuffixed 26110458 does join to HB29 and is not copied onto the suffix row.
- Six shared-refid events concatenate multiple tax bills with “;” and remain one KPI event and one ledger row: 26110094 HB1180;HB1358; 26110289 HB954;HB1008;HB1529; 26110461 SB316;SB591;SB649; 26110723 SB660;SB779; 26110724 SB660;SB779; 2619915 HB163;HB488;HB716;HB960.
- 20262 is HB30 only, 13 Yea. Other Special Session tax bills were not invented.
- A Nay on a substitute is not automatically opposition to the underlying bill. HB30 26110806 is N on Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A), not X. HB145 26110807 is N on the Senate-substitute rejection, not X. HB1279 26110881 is the named procedural/version Nay. SB388 26111279 is N on the conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A); a conference-agreed N is still N and is not flattened with HB1279. SB661 26111306 and 26111310 are the two conference Nays. SB661 26110685 is Yea on House passage with substitute; that Nay was not invented.
- McClure has zero X tokens in this tax universe. X is not Nay and not Yea. There are 0 P and 0 A; date-clustered Not Voting is not in this file.
- Category labels are title-derived. Residual Tax Administration / Other is used when a title does not clearly fit a Martinez bucket, including the six mixed shared-refid events. Counts sum to 118. Dollars were not invented.
- Four-tier labels used in the body: Documented Fact, Reported Claim, Analysis, Open Question. The vote ledger is behavior, not motive.
- Source of record: official 20261 and 20262 Virginia LIS session files (VOTE.CSV, BILLS.CSV, HISTORY.CSV, Summaries.csv, Members.csv) joined to H0375. This file is a client-format intelligence paper. It is not a public posting.
