Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — McPike has 95 recorded vote events across 26 tax-related bills: 87 Yea, 6 Nay, and 2 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 82 events on 25 tax bills (74 Yea, 6 Nay, 2 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. X is named in this body. It is not a cover KPI.

Coverage is source, not a recorded miss. H0406 is omitted from many 20261 VOTE.CSV rows. The member has 1,000 unique all-subject tokens in that file versus about 2,100 to 2,500 for other members in this batch. The first tax-universe HISTORY date is 2/18/2026 (vote H10V2613317 on SB400, Finance report, Yea). January and early-February floor tax votes, including 2619826 on HB175 and 26110089 on HB29, have no H0406 token. Those rows are not recorded as X. The member id is omitted. This paper does not backfill January floor votes, does not invent X for omitted rows, and does not treat the thin file as absence-as-pattern. 20262 coverage is complete: 13 tax events, all HB30, all Yea.

The record that is on file is one-sided on the Yea side. McPike supported 87 of 95 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax ideology label. High Yea is not an ideology label. The six Nays are version, vehicle, and conference events, not a rate census. McPike's Nay on 20261 vote 26110685, SB661, is House passage with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A) on the bill titled Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. That event is a version vote, not a rate census. McPike's Nay on 20261 vote 26110806, HB30, is the House rejection of Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. McPike's Nay on 20261 vote 26110807, HB145, is the House rejection of a Senate substitute (0-Y 93-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. That event is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill titled Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. McPike's Nay on 20261 vote 26110881, HB1279, is the House rejection of a Senate substitute (0-Y 95-N 0-A). That token is N. It is not X. That event is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill titled Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. McPike's remaining Nays on SB661 are conference events: vote 26111306, conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A), and vote 26111310, conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). A conference-agreed N is still N on that recorded action. All three SB661 events in this ledger are N. This paper does not flatten those three Nays into one, and it does not copy another member's Yea onto 26110685 or 26111310.

McPike recorded two Present/Not Voting (X) tokens, both in unusual venues. The first is 20261 vote H10002V2613630, SB788, subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (9-Y 0-N) on 2/24/2026. That token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay. McPike later recorded Yea on the SB788 Finance report and on House passage with amendments. The second is 20261 vote 26110584, HB30, contested committee amendment Item 491 #1h agreed to (64-Y 32-N 0-A) on 2/26/2026. That token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. Surrounding 2/26/2026 HB30 committee-amendment events in this ledger are Yea. This paper does not treat either X as a Nay, and it does not invent a floor miss from a subcommittee card.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean McPike uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-three of the 95 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. The thin 20261 file is a source gap. It is not a finding that he skipped January tax business as a pattern.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Three shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 95 events rather than splitting a single roll call. The peer six-pack events 26110094,

26110289, and 2619915 are not in this file. That omission is the coverage gap, not a filter rewrite, and those rows are not invented. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. McPike has 2 X, 0 P, and 0 A in this tax universe. One X sits in Sector/Excise Tax with SB788. One X sits in Budget / Appropriations with HB30 Item 491 #1h. There is no Personal Property Tax row because no such title is in this CSV.

Figure 2. Session split of the same 95 events. What it is: 20261 versus 20262 arithmetic on unique (session, vote_id) rows in his CSV. What it is not: a collapse of Special I into Regular, and not a backfill of omitted January 20261 rows. 20262 is HB30 only and is complete.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Six Nays. Two X. Zero P. Zero A. The two X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The six Nays named below are McPike's CSV tokens.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Three recorded Nays on the same bill, not one Nay flattened:

- 26110685 on 3/3/2026. H Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A). Token N. This is a version event, not a rate census.
- 26111306 on 3/14/2026. H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A). Token N.
- 26111310 on 3/14/2026. H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). Token N. A conference-agreed N is still N on that recorded action.

There is no Yea on SB661 in this ledger. This paper does not copy another member's Yea onto 26110685 or onto either conference event.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). McPike's token is N. It is not X. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. This is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle, not a standalone tax-rate roll. The separate HB30 X on 26110584 is a contested committee amendment, not this Senate-amendments rejection.

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). McPike's token is N. It is not X. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. McPike recorded Yea on 20261 vote 26111217, the conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A). That conference token is Y. It is not X. It is not a second Nay. Earlier HB145 committee and House-passage events are not in this CSV. That omission is the coverage gap, not a recorded X, and those rows are not invented.

Nay: HB1279 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote 26110881 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A). McPike's token is N. It is not X. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. This paper does not copy another member's Present/Not Voting (X) token onto 26110881. McPike recorded Yea on the other two HB1279 events in this ledger (conference report and Governor's recommendation). An earlier House-passage row is not in this CSV. That omission is the coverage gap, not a recorded X.

Analysis. Senate-substitute Nays and the HB30 Senate-amendments Nay are procedural/version events. The SB661 conference Nays are recorded tokens on those actions. A conference-agreed N is still N. They are not an ideology label, and they are not a tax-rate census. Neither of the two X tokens is a seventh Nay.

3. Present/Not Voting (X)

Documented Fact. Two Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. X is not N. X is not Y. Both sit in unusual venues. Neither is a floor Nay.

X: SB788 — Alcoholic beverage control; payment of excise tax on beer, wine coolers, and wine, penalties. Vote H10002V2613630 on 2/24/2026. Official recorded action: H Subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (9-Y 0-N). McPike's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay, and it is not absence from the later floor file. McPike recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (21-Y 0-N), and Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with amendments (91-Y 6-N 1-A).

X: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110584 on 2/26/2026. Official recorded action: H Contested committee amendment Item 491 #1h agreed to (64-Y 32-N 0-A). McPike's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. Vehicle is not item. Surrounding 2/26/2026 HB30 contested-amendment events in this ledger are Yea. This X is a different event from the 3/4/2026 Senate-amendments Nay on 26110806.

There are 0 Present (P) and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Date-clustered Not Voting is not present in this file beyond these two named X rows. Omitted January VOTE.CSV rows are not X.

4. Real & Personal Property Tax

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Only bills with an H0406 token in this CSV are listed. January real-property floor votes that appear in other members' files, including HB175 on 2619826, have no H0406 token and are not backfilled. Shared-refid SB649 on 26110461 is listed once in section 7 with its block event so a single roll call is not narrated twice. The standalone SB649 Finance report remains here.

HB854. Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. McPike recorded Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (90-Y 5-N 0-A).

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. McPike recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with substitute (11-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute (17-Y 4-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with substitute (70-Y 29-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (65-Y 31-N 0-A).

SB649. Real property tax; special assessment on basis of use, notice requirements. McPike recorded Yea on 2/18/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (21-Y 0-N).

5. Income Tax, Credits & Exemptions

Only bills with an H0406 token in this CSV are listed. Income-tax floor votes that sit before 2/18/2026 in other members' files are not invented here.

SB591. Income tax, state; free tax filing program for individuals. McPike recorded Yea on 2/18/2026, H Reported from Finance (21-Y 0-N).

SB612. Motion picture production; extends income tax credit sunset. McPike recorded Yea on 2/18/2026, H Reported from Finance (18-Y 3-N); Yea on 2/23/2026, H Passed House (74-Y 23-N 0-A).

HB400. Motion picture production; increases aggregate cap on tax credit, extends sunset. McPike recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (70-Y 24-N 0-A).

SB96. Income tax, corporate and state; credit for braille labeling program. McPike recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Referred from Finance and referred to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N).

HB1279. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. McPike recorded Nay on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 95-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (54-Y 41-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A).

SB388. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. McPike recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Passed House with amendments (61-Y 37-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (55-Y 40-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (62-Y 36-N 0-A).

6. Sales, Use & Local Taxation

The first tax-universe date in this file is the SB400 Finance report on 2/18/2026 (H10V2613317). House bills on local sales and use that appear only on January calendars in other members' files are not in this CSV and are not backfilled.

SB400. Admissions tax in counties; retail sales and use tax dedicated to promotion of tourism. McPike recorded Yea on 2/18/2026, H Reported from Finance (15-Y 6-N); Yea on 2/23/2026, H Passed House (62-Y 35-N 0-A).

SB314. Tourism improvement districts; transient occupancy tax in Arlington County. McPike recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Passed House (67-Y 30-N 0-A).

7. Business, Excise & Tax Administration

HB145. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. McPike recorded Nay on 3/4/2026, H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A).

SB129. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. McPike recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, H Passed House with substitute (91-Y 7-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (88-Y 7-N 0-A).

SB788. Alcoholic beverage control; payment of excise tax on beer, wine coolers, and wine, penalties. McPike recorded Present/Not Voting (X) on 2/24/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting with amendment(s) (9-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with amendment(s) (21-Y 0-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, H Passed House with amendments (91-Y 6-N 1-A).

SB302. Peanuts; excise tax, sunset extended. McPike recorded Yea on 2/24/2026, H Subcommittee recommends reporting (10-Y 0-N); Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance and referred to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N); Yea on 3/5/2026, H Passed House with substitute (95-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB661. Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. McPike recorded Nay on 3/3/2026, H Passed House with substitute (57-Y 39-N 1-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, H Conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, H Conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A).

HB1100. Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. McPike recorded Yea on 3/10/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (78-Y 19-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (73-Y 25-N 0-A).

SB597. Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. McPike recorded Yea on 2/23/2026, H Passed House (83-Y 14-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, H House concurred in Governor's recommendation (76-Y 20-N 0-A).

HB954. Rounding procedures; taxes and fees calculated, report. McPike recorded Yea on 3/6/2026, H Senate substitute agreed to by House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB224. Tax administration; award for tax underpayment detection assistance. McPike recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, H Reported from Finance with substitute and referred to Appropriations (21-Y 0-N).

Shared-refid block events

Three unique vote_ids attach to more than one tax bill. Each is one KPI event. Titles are concatenated in the CSV with a semicolon-space joiner. Bills are not invented, and the block is not flattened into one bill's recorded position. The other three events in the peer six-pack (26110094, 26110289, 2619915) are not in this file because H0406 is omitted from those VOTE.CSV rows. That is the coverage gap. Those rows are not invented, and they are not scored as X.

Yea on 20261 26110461 (2/23/2026): SB316; SB591; SB649 — Notarization, filing, & recordation of certain land records; duties of notary or settlement agent.; Income tax, state; free tax filing program for individuals.; Real property tax; special assessment on basis of use, notice requirements. Official recorded action: H Passed House with substitute (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110723 (3/4/2026): SB660; SB779 — Virginia Self-Service Storage Act; disposal of abandoned personal property in certain cases.; Eminent domain; condemnation proceedings, entry of order and recordation of certificate. Official recorded action: H Passed House (97-Y 0-N 0-A).

Yea on 20261 26110724 (3/4/2026): SB660; SB779 — Virginia Self-Service Storage Act; disposal of abandoned personal property in certain cases.; Eminent domain; condemnation proceedings, entry of order and recordation of certificate. Official recorded action: H Passed House (99-Y 0-N 0-A).

8. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30)

HB29 and HB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. McPike has one 20261 HB29 event in this ledger: vote 26110458 on 2/20/2026, Senate amendments agreed to by House (59-Y 35-N 0-A), token Yea. January HB29 floor events, including 26110089, have no H0406 token. That omission is not X. This paper does not backfill those rows.

On 20261 HB30 he recorded 39 events: 37 Yea, one X on 26110584 (contested committee amendment Item 491 #1h agreed to, 64-Y 32-N 0-A), and one Nay on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). That N is the unanimous rejection roll. It is not X. The Item 491 X is not that Nay. House passage on 2/26/2026 is Yea (83-Y 14-N 0-A).

20262 is HB30 only: 13 Yea events, including the conference report agreed to by House (71-Y 22-N 0-A) and House concurrences in Governor’s recommendations numbered 1 through 14. 20262 coverage is complete. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). McPike supported 87 of 95 recorded tax-universe events. The six Nays are version, vehicle, and conference actions: one SB661 House-substitute passage (57-Y 39-N 1-A), one HB30 Senate-amendments rejection (House 0-Y 92-N 0-A), one HB145 Senate-substitute rejection (House 0-Y 93-N 0-A), one HB1279 Senate-substitute rejection (House 0-Y 95-N 0-A), one SB661 conference report rejected by House (49-Y 44-N 3-A), and one SB661 conference report agreed to by House (57-Y 38-N 1-A). The two X tokens are H10002V2613630 on SB788 (subcommittee report with amendments, 9-Y 0-N) and 26110584 on HB30 (contested committee amendment Item 491 #1h, 64-Y 32-N 0-A). Those tokens are X, not Nay and not Yea. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, and budget vehicles, the record that is on file is better described as broad support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

The thin 20261 universe is a source gap. H0406 is omitted from many VOTE.CSV rows. The first tax date is 2/18/2026. January floor tax votes are not recorded as X; the member id is omitted. This paper does not convert that omission into a pattern of absence, a cluster of misses, or an invented January card. 20262 is complete at 13 HB30 Yea events.

McPike has two X tokens in this tax universe and zero Present (P) and zero Abstain (A) tokens. Date-clustered Not Voting is not an issue beyond those two named X rows.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, cannot be read from the missing January rows, because those rows do not contain an H0406 token. On the events that are recorded, the scarcity of floor policy Nays means differences are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — not in McPike’s Yea rate on this thin file. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why he voted.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 Senate substitute (Nay on 26110807) versus the conference report (Yea on 26111217), the HB1279 Senate substitute versus the conference report, the three SB661 vehicles (all N), the HB30 Senate amendments versus the House-passed vehicle, and the two unusual-venue X cards (SB788 subcommittee and HB30 Item 491 #1h), is not compared in this paper. Governor-recommendation text on 20262 HB30 is not lined to any single tax item. Why H0406 is omitted from many 20261 VOTE.CSV rows is not answered by this ledger.

10. Priority Follow-Up Research

- Coverage gap — Keep 2/18/2026 (H10V2613317) as the first tax date. Do not backfill January floor votes, including 2619826 HB175 and 26110089 HB29. Do not invent X for omitted rows. Do not treat the thin file as absence-as-pattern. The gap is source.
- SB661 — Keep the three Nays as three recorded actions: House passage with substitute 26110685, conference rejected 26111306, and conference agreed 26111310. A conference-agreed N is still N. Compare versions. Do not flatten the three Nays into one or copy another member’s Yea onto 26110685 or 26111310.
- HB30 — McPike’s token on the Senate-amendments rejection (0-Y 92-N 0-A) is N, not X. McPike’s token on contested committee amendment Item 491 #1h (26110584) is X, not N. Do not flatten those two events. Do not copy another member’s token onto either HISTORY sentence.

- HB145 — McPike’s token on the Senate-substitute rejection (0-Y 93-N 0-A) is N, not X. Procedural/version, not policy opposition. McPike’s token on the conference report agreed (87-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26111217, is Y, not X and not N. Compare the House bill, the rejected Senate substitute, and the conference report. Do not invent earlier committee Yeas that are not in this CSV.
- HB1279 — McPike’s token on 26110881 is N, not X. Compare the Senate substitute rejected 0-Y 95-N 0-A, the conference report (54-Y 41-N 0-A), and the Governor’s recommendation (62-Y 38-N 0-A) before assigning substantive meaning to the procedural Nay. Do not invent a House-passage row that is not in this CSV.
- SB788 — The subcommittee token H10002V2613630 is X, not a floor Nay. The Finance report and House passage with amendments are Yea.
- Shared-refid blocks in this file are three, not six: 26110461 SB316;SB591;SB649; 26110723 SB660;SB779; 26110724 SB660;SB779. Do not invent 26110094, 26110289, or 2619915. Do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position.
- HISTORY join gaps: 22 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item. 20262 coverage is complete.

Methodology & Evidence Limits

- Subject lock: official LIS member ID H0406, name token Kirk McPike. House District 5 | HD-5 | Alexandria (part) | Democrat is the task identity for this product. Members.csv columns on disk are MBR_HOU, MBR_MBRNO, and MBR_NAME only; they do not print party or district. Official member page: <https://house.vga.virginia.gov/members/H0406>
- Universe = H0406 token in VOTE.CSV joined to a bill that passes build_taxes.is_tax_bill (imported, not rewritten): keyword plus Title 58.1 summary plus forced budget vehicles (HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30/(HB | SB)600x), minus land-use-only data-center false positives. High Yea is not an ideology label. Budget vehicles and version votes sit in the same filter.
- Join: vote_id.strip() == History_refid.strip(). Unique events are counted as (session, vote_id). CSV rows = 95 (20261 = 82, 20262 = 13). Token mix: Y=87, N=6, X=2, P=0, A=0. Unique tax bills with at least one H0406 token: 26 (20261 = 25, 20262 = 1). 20261 and 20262 are not collapsed in the appendix.

- Coverage gap is source. H0406 appears in 1,000 unique 20261 VOTE.CSV rows versus about 2,100 to 2,500 for other batch members. First tax-universe HISTORY date is 2/18/2026 (H10V2613317). January and early-February floor tax votes (including 2619826 HB175 and 26110089 HB29) have no H0406 token; they are not recorded as X; the member id is omitted. This paper does not backfill January floor votes, does not invent X for omitted rows, and does not treat the thin file as absence-as-pattern. 20262 coverage is complete (13 tax events, all HB30, all Yea).
- The Martinez first-pass paper screen of 34/26/33/1 is a different denominator. This ledger was not forced to look like that screen.
- 2025 files and va-member-votes-wide.csv were not used.
- HISTORY join gaps: 22 unjoined unique 20261 vote_ids and 3 unjoined unique 20262 vote_ids cannot be assigned a bill and were not scored as tax. Bills were not invented for those IDs. 20261 unjoined: 26110456, 26110457, 26110458X, 26110460, 26110478, 26110506, 26110555, 26110609, 26110644, 26110683, 26110722, 26110815, 26110830, 26110888, 26110916, 26110983, 26111099, 26111159, 26111161, 26111209, 26111323, 26111457. 20262 unjoined: 26211458, 26211487, 26211490. One unjoined ID is a VOTE.CSV duplicate row with a trailing X on the vote_id (26110458X); the unsuffixed 26110458 does join to HB29 and is not copied onto the suffix row. 20262 26211458 is VOTE.CSV line 1 (live vote, H0406 Y) with no History_refid; the bill is not guessed.
- Three shared-refid events concatenate multiple tax bills with “;” and remain one KPI event and one ledger row: 26110461 SB316;SB591;SB649; 26110723 SB660;SB779; 26110724 SB660;SB779. The peer six-pack events 26110094, 26110289, and 2619915 are not in this file because of the coverage gap and are not invented.
- 20262 is HB30 only, 13 Yea. Other Special Session tax bills were not invented.
- A Nay on a substitute is not automatically opposition to the underlying bill. SB661 26110685 is N on House passage with substitute. HB30 26110806 is N on Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A), not X. HB145 26110807 is N on the Senate-substitute rejection, not X. HB1279 26110881 is N on the Senate-substitute rejection, not X. SB661 26111306 and 26111310 are the two conference Nays; a conference-agreed N is still N. HB145 26111217 is Y on the conference report agreed to by House; that token is not X and not N.
- McPike has two X tokens in this tax universe: H10002V2613630 (SB788 subcommittee) and 26110584 (HB30 Item 491 #1h). X is not Nay and not Yea. A subcommittee X is not a floor Nay. There are 0 P and 0 A. Omitted VOTE.CSV rows are not X.
- Category labels are title-derived. Residual Tax Administration / Other is used when a title does not clearly fit a Martinez bucket, including the three mixed shared-refid events and SB224. Counts sum to 95. Dollars were not invented. Personal Property Tax is absent because no such title is in this CSV.
- Four-tier labels used in the body: Documented Fact, Reported Claim, Analysis, Open Question. The vote ledger is behavior, not motive.
- Source of record: official 20261 and 20262 Virginia LIS session files (VOTE.CSV, BILLS.CSV, HISTORY.CSV, Summaries.csv, Members.csv) joined to H0406. This file is a client-format intelligence paper. It is not a public posting.
