Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — McQuinn has 123 recorded vote events across 51 tax-related bills: 117 Yea, 2 Nay, and 4 Present/Not Voting (X). There are no Present (P) and no Abstain (A) records in this tax universe. 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 110 events on 50 tax bills (104 Yea, 2 Nay, 4 X). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 13 events on one bill, HB30: 13 Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. X is not Nay and is not absence.

The Regular-session record is one-sided on the Yea side. McQuinn supported 117 of 123 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The two Nays are two recorded actions in her H0207 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a third Nay. This paper does not invent HB1279 as Nay. Do not copy LeVere Bolling H0372 three-Nay HB1279-as-N onto McQuinn. The two Nays, named and unflattened, are 26110806 on HB30 (Senate amendments rejected by House, 0-Y 92-N 0-A) and 26110807 on HB145 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 93-N 0-A). Those two are the complete Nay set. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. The HB145 Nay is a Senate-substitute rejection. It is procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. HB1279 Senate substitute rejected on 26110881 is X for this member, not N. Peers often recorded N on that HISTORY sentence. Her token is X. Keep 26110881 as X. Floor passage of HB1279 on 26110016 is Yea. Conference report agreed on 26111245 is Yea. Governor's recommendation on 26111389 is Yea. This CSV has no Counties, Cities and Towns subcommittee or report tokens on HB1279 for H0207. This paper does not invent those committee tokens. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. SB661 has three recorded events in this CSV, all Yea: House passage with substitute (26110685), conference report rejected (26111306), and conference report agreed (26111310). Keep 26111306 as Yea. Do not invent an SB661 Nay. Do not convert 26111306 or 26111310 to X. Peers may have N or X on those HISTORY sentences. This paper does not copy those tokens. HB550 on 2619971 is Yea. SB400 on 26110470 is Yea. This paper does not invent admissions-tax Nays. This CSV has no HB919 event. This paper does not invent one.

Four X tokens stay X. They are not flattened to N and they are not treated as absence. All four sit in 20261. None sit in 20262. The four are 2619884 on HJ34 (Agreed to by House, 68-Y 25-N 0-A); 26110865 on HB854 (Senate substitute agreed to by House, 90-Y 5-N 0-A); 26110870 on HB954 (Senate substitute agreed to by House, 97-Y 0-N 0-A); and 26110881 on HB1279 (Senate substitute rejected by House, 0-Y 95-N 0-A). Keep 26110881 as X. It is not N. It is not Y. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write Willett H0327's Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. Vote 26110590 on HB30 Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h is Yea for McQuinn. It is not X. It is not N. Votes 26110507 and 26110567 on HB30 are Yea for this member. They are not X. Unjoined rows are not scored as tax. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. Vote 26110137 on HB958 is Yea. That Yea is not A.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean McQuinn uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Sixty of the 123 events are HB29/HB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. A high X count is not absence. The four X tokens are recorded Present/Not Voting tokens on one House-agreement study resolution, two Senate-substitute agreements, and one Senate-substitute rejection. They are not missing votes and they are not Nays.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Six shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once in Tax Administration / Other so the table sums to 123 events rather than splitting a single roll call. All six shared-refid events are Yea:

26110094, 26110289, 26110461, 26110723, 26110724, and 2619915. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 4 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The two Nays sit in Budget / Appropriations (HB30 26110806) and Sector/Excise Tax (HB145 26110807). The four X tokens sit in Personal Property Tax (HJ34 2619884), Real Property Tax (HB854 26110865), Tax Administration / Other (HB954 26110870), and Tax Exemptions (HB1279 26110881). There is no scored A.

Documented Fact. Two Nays. Four X. Zero P. Zero A. The four X tokens are not listed here. They are named in section 3. The two Nays named below are McQuinn's H0207 CSV tokens. Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a third Nay. This paper does not invent HB1279 as Nay. Do not copy LeVere Bolling H0372 three-Nay HB1279-as-N onto McQuinn. This paper does not invent HB550 or SB400 Nays. This paper does not invent an SB661 Nay. McQuinn recorded Yea on House passage of HB550, on House passage of SB400, and on all three SB661 events in this CSV.

Nay: HB30 — Budget Bill. Vote 26110806 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate amendments rejected by House (0-Y 92-N 0-A). McQuinn's token is N. This is a version/vehicle vote on a forced budget vehicle. The House rejected the Senate amendments unanimously. It is not a standalone tax-rate roll. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. McQuinn recorded Yea on 39 of 40 Regular-session HB30 events in this ledger, including House passage (83-Y 14-N 0-A) on 26110593 and Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h on 26110590. Votes 26110507 and 26110567 on HB30 are Yea for this member. They are not X. They are not this Nay.

Nay: HB145 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote 26110807 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute rejected by House (0-Y 93-N 0-A). McQuinn's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The House rejected the Senate substitute unanimously. It is not policy

opposition to the underlying bill. Peers may have X on this HISTORY sentence. This paper does not copy those tokens. McQuinn recorded Yea on Appropriations report (22-Y 0-N), vote H02V2612879; Yea on House passage (89-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26110434; and Yea on the conference report agreed to by House (87-Y 8-N 0-A), vote 26111217. Those Yea tokens are not this Nay. This CSV has four HB145 events for H0207. This paper does not invent General Laws subcommittee or General Laws report tokens absent from this CSV.

Analysis. The two Nays are one version/vehicle budget event (HB30 26110806) and one Senate-substitute rejection (HB145 26110807). The Senate-substitute Nay is procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. This paper does not invent HB550 or SB400 Nays. This paper does not invent HB1279 as Nay. Vote 26110881 on HB1279 is X, named in section 3. SB388 has no Nay in this ledger. SB661 has no Nay in this ledger. All three SB661 tokens stay Yea. There is no scored A. The four X tokens are not a third Nay.

This paper does not invent those committee tokens.

X: HB854 — Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. Vote 26110865 on 3/6/2026. Official recorded action: H Senate substitute agreed to by House (90-Y 5-N 0-A). McQuinn's token is X. It is not N. It is not Y. House passage on 2619951 is Yea. This CSV has no Finance subcommittee or Finance report tokens on HB854 for H0207. This paper does not invent those committee tokens.

The unsuffixed 26110458 joins HB29 as Yea when present. The trailing-X duplicate 26110458X is unjoined and is not scored as tax. This paper does not invent a bill for 26110458X.

On 20261 HB30 she recorded Yea on 39 events (Appropriations report with amendment(s) on H02V2613506, committee amendments, floor amendments passed by including Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h on 26110590, constitutional reading, and House passage 83-Y 14-N 0-A) and Nay on 26110806 when the House rejected Senate amendments (0-Y 92-N 0-A). There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. Special I is 13 Yea. This paper does not write Willett H0327's Special I 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster onto this member. 9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). McQuinn supported 117 of 123 recorded tax-universe events. The two Nays are two recorded actions: HB30 Senate amendments rejected (26110806, 0-Y 92-N 0-A) and HB145

Senate substitute rejected (26110807, 0-Y 93-N 0-A). Those two are the complete Nay set. The Senate-substitute Nay is procedural/version. The HB30 Nay is a version/vehicle event on a forced budget vehicle. Four X tokens stay X: 26119884, 26110865, 26110870, and 26110881. Keep 26110881 as X. Do not invent HB1279 as Nay. Do not copy LeVere Bolling H0372 three-Nay HB1279-as-N onto McQuinn. Vote 26110590 on HB30 Floor Amendment Item 4-14 #1h is Yea, not X. HB550 26119971 is Yea. SB400 26110470 is Yea. SB661 is Yea on all three events, including both conference tokens. This paper does not invent an SB661 Nay. This paper does not invent admissions-tax Nays. HB1279 floor passage on 26110016 is Yea. HB1279 conference on 26111245 is Yea. SB388 has no Nay. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, committee rolls, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad support for the House majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus, with a documented two-event Nay set that includes one procedural Senate-substitute rejection and one budget version/vehicle Nay, plus four Present/Not Voting tokens that stay X, than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including McQuinn's Yea on 26110590 where peers may have X, her Nay on 26110806 where peers may have X, her Nay on 26110807 where peers may have X, her X on 26110881 where peers often recorded N, her X on HJ34 26119884 where peers often recorded Y, her X on HB854 26110865 and HB954 26110870 where peers often recorded Y, her Yea on HB550 26119971 and SB400 26110470 where peers may have N, her Yea on SB661 26110685, 26111306, and 26111310 where peers may have N or X, her Yea on shared-refid 26110723 where some peers recorded X, and her Special I 13 Yea rather than a 1 Yea plus 12 X cluster. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted. This ledger is H0207 only. H0177 tokens are not scored. H0334 tokens are not scored. H0340 tokens are not scored. H0404 tokens are not scored. H0393 tokens are not scored. H0372 tokens are not scored. H0327 tokens are not scored. H0388 tokens are not scored.

Open Question. Version text on the HB145 Senate substitute versus the later conference report is not compared in this paper. Version text on the HB1279 Senate substitute versus the later conference report is not compared. Version text on the SB661 House-substitute vehicle and the two conference reports is not compared. Senate-amendment text on 20261 HB30 26110806 is not lined to any single tax item. Floor-amendment Item 4-14 #1h text on 26110590 is not lined to any single tax item. Why McQuinn's token on 26110881 is X while peers often recorded N is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens. Why her tokens on HJ34 26119884, HB854 26110865, and HB954 26110870 are X while peers often recorded Y is not established beyond the recorded tokens.
