Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Lamont Bagby has 190 recorded vote events across 57 tax-related bills: 161 Yea, 5 Nay, 24 Present/Not Voting (X), 0 Present (P), and 0 Abstain (A). 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 175 events on 56 tax bills (146 Yea, 5 Nay, 24 X, 0 A). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 15 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. There is no Special I A. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. High Yea is not ideology. Disclose X=24. A=0. Do not invent an Abstain. Do not invent a sixth Nay. Do not convert Voice Vote X rows to Nay.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side. Bagby supported 161 of 190 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The five Nays are five recorded actions in his S0114 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a sixth Nay. The five Nays, named and unflattened, are SV713 on SB30 (Suetterlein Floor Amendment item 3-5.24 #1s rejected, 19-Y 21-N 0-A); SV714 on SB30 (Sturtevant Floor Amendment item 4-14 #6s rejected, 19-Y 21-N 0-A); SV744 on SB388 (Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by Senate); SV949 on SB129 (House substitute rejected by Senate, 0-Y 40-N 0-A); and SV950 on SB661 (House substitute rejected by Senate, 0-Y 40-N 0-A). SV949 and SV950 are House-substitute rejections by the Senate. They are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. Bagby does not carry Deeds-only Nays on 20261 SV39 or 20261 SV48. On HB30 conference report agreed (SV39) and Governor's recommendation No. 4 (SV48), Bagby's 20261 and 20262 tokens are Yea.

There are 24 Present/Not Voting (X) tokens in this tax universe. Disclose X=24. Many are Voice Vote HISTORY sentences. Keep them as X. Voice Vote X stays X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. Shared-refid VSV937 is X across HB163; HB282; HB474; HB524; HB557; HB1358 and remains one KPI event. The 24 X vote_ids are S10V10, VSV175, S10V23, S13V1659, VSV877, VSV878, VSV879, VSV880, VSV937, VSV939, VSV940, VSV941, VSV942, VSV943, VSV944, VSV945, VSV946, VSV947, VSV948, VSV949, S5V2372, S5V2382, S5V2395, and VSV1094. SV1428 is Yea on SB129 conference in this CSV. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. A=0. Special I is 15 Yea on HB30. This paper does not invent other Special Session tax bills.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Bagby uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, voice votes, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Seventy-four of the 190 events are HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. X is not N. Disclose X=24. A=0.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Fourteen shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once (Budget / Appropriations when a forced budget vehicle is among the bills; otherwise Tax Administration / Other) so the table sums to 190 events rather than splitting a single roll call. Thirteen of the fourteen shared-refid events are Yea; VSV937 is X. Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 24 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The five Nays sit in Budget / Appropriations (SB30 SV713, SB30 SV714), Tax Exemptions (SB388 SV744), and Sector/Excise Tax (SB129 SV949, SB661 SV950). Disclose X=24. There is no scored A.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Five Nays. Twenty-four X. Zero P. Zero A. The twenty-four X tokens are named in section 3. There is no A token to name in section 3. The five Nays named below are Bagby's S0114 CSV tokens. Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a sixth Nay. House-substitute rejections by Senate are procedural/version. High Yea is not ideology. High Yea is not a tax-rate census. Do not copy Deeds Nays on 20261 SV39 or 20261 SV48 onto Bagby.

Nay: SB30 — Budget Bill. Vote SV713 on 2/26/2026. Official recorded action: S Senator Suetterlein Floor Amendment item 3-5.24 #1s rejected (19-Y 21-N 0-A). Bagby's token is N. This is a floor-amendment vote on a forced budget vehicle. It is not a standalone tax-rate roll.

Nay: SB30 — Budget Bill. Vote SV714 on 2/26/2026. Official recorded action: S Senator Sturtevant Floor Amendment item 4-14 #6s rejected (19-Y 21-N 0-A). Bagby's token is N. This is a second floor-amendment vote on the same budget vehicle. It is not flattened into SV713.

Nay: SB388 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote SV744 on 2/27/2026. Official recorded action: S Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by Senate. Bagby's token is N. Other SB388 events in this ledger include Senate passage Yea (SV331), conference Yea (SV1416), and Governor's recommendation Yea (SV1564). Those Yea tokens are not this Nay.

Nay: SB129 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote SV949 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: S House substitute rejected by Senate (0-Y 40-N 0-A). Bagby's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The Senate rejected the House substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Senate passage on SV380 is Yea. Conference report on SV1428 is Yea in this CSV.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote SV950 on 3/4/2026. Official recorded action: S House substitute rejected by Senate (0-Y 40-N 0-A). Bagby's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The Senate rejected the House substitute unanimously. It is not

policy opposition to the underlying bill. Later conference and reconsideration events on SB661 in this CSV are Yea (SV1431, SV1458, SV1511, SV1512, SV1513).

Analysis. The five Nays are two SB30 floor-amendment events, one SB388 Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejection, and two House-substitute rejections by Senate (SB129 SV949 and SB661 SV950, procedural/version). House-sub Nays are not a tax-rate census. Special I has no Nay. Bagby has no SV39/SV48 Nay. High Yea is not ideology. Bagby has no Nay on 20261 SV39 or 20261 SV48.

3. Present/Not Voting (X) and Abstain (A)

Documented Fact. Twenty-four Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. Zero Abstain (A). Zero Present (P). X is not N. X is not Y. X is not absence. A is not N. A is not X. A is not Y. A is not absence. Disclose X=24. A=0. Many X rows are Voice Vote HISTORY sentences. Keep them as X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. Do not invent additional X rows. Bagby's X set includes S10V10 (SR6), S10V23 (SJ38), S13V1659 (HB1100), S5V2382 (HB175), and S5V2395 (HB1142), plus Voice Vote and committee X rows named in the block below. SV1428 on SB129 conference is Yea in this S0114 CSV, not X. All 24 sit in 20261. None sit in 20262. Special I is 15 Yea.

S10V10 — S10V10 / SR6 (1/30/2026): S Rereferred from Rules to Finance and Appropriations (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV175 — VSV175 / SB597 (2/2/2026): S Committee substitute agreed to (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

S10V23 — S10V23 / SJ38 (2/6/2026): S Passed by indefinitely in Rules (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

S13V1659 — S13V1659 / HB1100 (2/18/2026): S Rereferred from Courts of Justice to General Laws and Technology (12-Y 0-N). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV877 — VSV877 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendments agreed to (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV878 — VSV878 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendment Item 77 #1s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV879 — VSV879 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendment Item 4-5.04 #1s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

S5V2382 — S5V2382 / HB175 (3/3/2026): S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (12-Y 2-N). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

S5V2395 — S5V2395 / HB1142 (3/3/2026): S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 0-N). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV1094 — VSV1094 / HB1100 (3/6/2026): S Passed by for the day Block Vote (Voice Vote). Bagby's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

There are 0 Present (P) tokens, 24 Present/Not Voting (X) tokens, and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. The five Nays named in section 2 are N, not X. Shared-refid VSV937 stays X and stays one KPI event. Special I is 15 Yea. This paper does not write a Special I Present/Not Voting cluster onto this member.

4. Real & Personal Property Tax

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Shared-refid property titles that appear only inside block events are listed once in section 7 so a single roll call is not narrated twice. Exact personal-property vehicles in this CSV include HB557, HB960, and HJ34 where scored. Bagby also has SR6 (S10V10 X) and SJ38 (S10V23 X) in this tax CSV; those Present/Not Voting tokens stay X.

SR6. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. Bagby recorded Present/Not Voting (X) on 1/30/2026, S Rereferred from Rules to Finance and Appropriations (Voice Vote).

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/2/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S House substitute agreed to by Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (21-Y 18-N 0-A).

HB175. Real property; tax exemption, surviving spouses of members of Armed Forces who died in line of duty. Bagby recorded Present/Not Voting (X) on 3/3/2026, S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (12-Y 2-N).

HB282. Real property tax; classification of land and improvement in Cities of Charlottesville/Falls Church. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 1-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, S Passed Senate (40-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB474. Real estate with delinquent taxes or liens; apptmt. of special commissioner, increases value. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 0-N).

HB557. Tangible personal property tax; establishes classification for electric landscaping equipment. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (9-Y 4-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, S Passed Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A).

HB854. Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations with substitute (15-Y 0-N).

HB960. Personal property taxes; valuation, effective clause. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (15-Y 0-N).

HJ34. Qualifying vehicles, certain; Dept. of Tax. to study options for abolishing personal property tax. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/6/2026, S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (10-Y 4-N).

HB1358. Real property tax; special assessment on basis of use, notice requirements. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 0-N).

5. Income Tax, Credits & Exemptions

SB388 tokens named in section 2 remain those recorded actions. One of seven SB388 events is Nay (SV744). That Nay is the Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejection. Senate passage, conference, and Governor's recommendation on SB388 are Yea. HB1279, HB167, and SB367 appear where exact events exist in this CSV. Income-tax subtraction, credit, and bracket vehicles in this ledger are Yea where scored. Do not invent committee tokens absent from this CSV.

SB96. Income tax, corporate and state; credit for braille labeling program. Bagby recorded Yea on 1/23/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (39-Y 0-N 0-A).

SB388. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/3/2026, S Constitutional reading dispensed (on 1st reading) (39-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 2/11/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (21-Y 18-N 0-A); Nay on 2/27/2026, S Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by Senate; Yea on 3/4/2026, S Senate acceded to request (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (21-Y 17-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (21-Y 18-N 0-A).

SB612. Motion picture production; extends income tax credit sunset. Bagby recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (24-Y 16-N 0-A).

HB167. Tax exemptions; Confederacy organizations. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate (21-Y 17-N 0-A).

HB400. Motion picture production; increases aggregate cap on tax credit, extends sunset. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (12-Y 3-N); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (25-Y 15-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Reconsideration of Senate passage agreed to by Senate (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (24-Y 16-N 0-A).

HB716. Income tax, state; innocent spouse tax relief. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (15-Y 0-N).

HB958. Income tax, corporate; taxable income, net operating loss. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 1-N).

HB1180. Income tax, state; free tax filing program for individuals. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate Block Vote (39-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB1279. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Constitutional reading dispensed Block Vote (on 2nd reading) (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (21-Y 17-N 0-A); Yea on 3/10/2026, S Senate insisted on substitute (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (23-Y 16-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (23-Y 16-N 0-A).

6. Sales, Use & Local Taxation

Admissions-tax and retail sales vehicles in this ledger are drawn from exact bill events in the S0114 CSV. Shared-refid block events that concatenate sales or local titles are listed in section 7. Do not invent subcommittee tokens absent from this CSV.

SB314. Tourism improvement districts; transient occupancy tax in Arlington County. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/11/2026, S Read third time and defeated by Senate (20-Y 18-N 0-A); Yea on 2/11/2026, S Reconsideration of defeated action agreed to by Senate; Yea on 2/11/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (23-Y 17-N 0-A); Yea on 2/11/2026, S Reconsideration of passage agreed to by Senate.

SB400. Admissions tax in counties; retail sales and use tax dedicated to promotion of tourism. Bagby recorded Yea on 1/30/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (25-Y 12-N 0-A).

SB763. Retail Sales and Use Tax; definitions, imposes firearm and ammunition tax. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/6/2026, S Read third time and passed Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A).

SJ38. Craft beer industry; Department of Taxation to prepare a report on local taxation. Bagby recorded Present/Not Voting (X) on 2/6/2026, S Passed by indefinitely in Rules (Voice Vote).

HB334. Additional local sales and use tax to support schools; referendum. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/9/2026, S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 0-N).

HB341. Plastic bag tax; distribution to towns. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate (22-Y 16-N 0-A).

HB524. Tourism improvement districts; transient occupancy tax in Arlington County. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/25/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (10-Y 5-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, S Passed Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A).

HB550. Admissions tax in counties; retail sales and use tax dedicated to promotion of tourism. Bagby recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate (24-Y 14-N 0-A).

HB897. Retail Sales and Use Tax; exemption for data centers, delayed effective date. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Passed by indefinitely in Finance and Appropriations (15-Y 0-N).

HB915. Local taxation; tax extension for federal government shutdown. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Reported from Finance and Appropriations (14-Y 1-N); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate (39-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB1008. Motor vehicle sales and use tax; exemption for electric vehicles, etc. Bagby recorded Yea on 3/3/2026, S Continued to next session in Finance and Appropriations (15-Y 0-N).

7. Business, Excise & Tax Administration

SB129 and SB661 House-substitute rejections (SV949, SV950) are N and remain procedural/version as named in section 2. SB129 conference SV1428 is Yea in this CSV. SB661 later conference and reconsideration events in this CSV are Yea. Do not invent bills absent from this CSV. SV1428 on SB129 conference is Yea in this S0114 CSV.

SB129. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. 8. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30 / SB29 / SB30)

HB29, HB30, SB29, and SB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. On SB30, Bagby recorded Yea on committee and floor vehicles that join in this CSV, X on eleven Voice Vote / block-vote committee-amendment and reading-waiver events (VSV939–VSV949), and Nay on SV713 and SV714 when the Suetterlein and Sturtevant floor amendments were rejected. Those Nays are floor-amendment events on a forced budget vehicle. Keep the Voice Vote X rows as X.

On HB29, four committee-amendment Voice Vote events are X (VSV877–VSV880) and other exact HB29 events in this CSV are Yea. On SB29, exact events in this CSV are Yea. On 20261 HB30, Bagby recorded Yea on conference report agreed (SV39), Yea on Governor's recommendation No. 4 (SV48), X on Finance and Appropriations report S5V2372, and Yea on the remaining exact 20261 HB30 events in this ledger, including Senate passage with amendments (SV888) and other Governor-recommendation concurrences. Sessions stay separate. Bagby has no SV39/SV48 Nay. Do not invent Deeds-only Nays on SV39 or SV48.

20262 is HB30 only: 15 events, all Yea, including SV39 conference report agreed and SV45–SV58 Governor's recommendations Nos. 1–14. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. There is no Special I A. Special I is 15 Yea. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). Bagby supported 161 of 190 recorded tax-universe events. The five Nays are five recorded actions: SB30 Suetterlein floor amendment rejected (SV713); SB30 Sturtevant floor amendment rejected (SV714); SB388 Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected (SV744); SB129 House substitute rejected by Senate (SV949, procedural/version); and SB661 House substitute rejected by Senate (SV950, procedural/version). Those five are the complete Nay set. House-sub Nays are procedural/version. There are 24 Present/Not Voting (X) tokens, many on Voice Vote HISTORY sentences. Disclose X=24. Keep them as X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. There is no Abstain. Special I is 15 Yea on HB30. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, committee rolls, voice votes, and budget vehicles, the record is better described as broad support for the Senate majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus, with a documented five-event Nay set that includes two procedural House-substitute rejections and two budget-vehicle floor-amendment events, and with twenty-four Present/Not Voting tokens and zero Abstain tokens, than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Bagby has twenty-four Present/Not Voting (X) tokens in this tax universe, zero Present (P) tokens, and zero Abstain (A) tokens. X=24. X is not Nay and is not absence. A is not Nay and is not X. Shared-refid events SV119, SV140, SV148, SV220, SV297, SV355, SV550, SV699, SV748, SV866, SV887, SV956, and SV958 are Yea. Shared-refid VSV937 is X. On HB30 SV39 and SV48, Bagby's 20261 and 20262 tokens are Yea. Bagby's X set includes S10V10, S10V23, S13V1659, S5V2382, and S5V2395.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Bagby's procedural Nays on SV949 and SV950, his floor-amendment Nays on SV713 and SV714, his Nay on SB388 SV744, and his X on Voice Vote budget amendments — rather than any invented sixth Nay. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why he voted. This paper does not invent votes or a tax posture from party or district labels. This ledger is S0114 only. Hashmi S0108 tokens are not scored. Ebbin S0085 tokens are not scored. House LIS ids are not scored.

Open Question. Version text on the SB129 and SB661 House substitutes versus later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Floor-amendment item text on SV713 and SV714 is not lined to any single tax item. Why Voice Vote rows carry X rather than Y or N is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens.

10. Priority Follow-Up Research

SB30 SV713 and SV714 are N on floor amendments rejected. Those five are the complete Nay set. Bagby has no Nay on 20261 SV39 or 20261 SV48.
- X is X. It is not Nay and not Yea. It is not absence. There are 24 scored X tokens. Disclose X=24. Many are Voice Vote. Keep them as X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. Bagby's X set includes S10V10, S10V23, S13V1659, S5V2382, and S5V2395 from this S0114 CSV. SV1428 is Yea, not X. A is A. There are 0 scored A tokens. A=0. There are 0 P.
- Category labels are title-derived. Residual Tax Administration / Other is used when a title does not clearly fit a Martinez bucket, including mixed shared-refid events. Counts sum to 190. Dollars were not invented.
- Four-tier labels used in the body: Documented Fact, Reported Claim, Analysis, Open Question. The vote ledger is behavior, not motive.
