Executive Assessment

Bottom line. Using the disclosed 2026 *is_tax_bill* screen — keyword plus Title 58.1 plus forced budget vehicles — Elizabeth B. Bennett-Parker has 104 recorded vote events across 32 tax-related bills: 79 Yea, 8 Nay, 17 Present/Not Voting (X), 0 Present (P), and 0 Abstain (A). 2026 Regular (session 20261) accounts for 89 events on 31 tax bills (64 Yea, 8 Nay, 17 X, 0 A). 2026 Special I (session 20262) accounts for 15 events on one bill, HB30, all Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. There is no Special I A. Spec I is all Yea. This is a thin universe relative to Senate peers: S0135 is omitted from many early 20261 VOTE.CSV rows, and the first tax-universe HISTORY date is 2/19/2026 (SV556). That is a source gap, not a filter rewrite. Do not backfill. Do not invent earlier votes. High Yea is not a higher-tax or lower-tax label. High Yea is not ideology. Disclose X=17. A=0. Do not invent an Abstain. Do not invent a ninth Nay. Do not convert Voice Vote X rows to Nay.

The record is one-sided on the Yea side among the events that exist. Bennett-Parker supported 79 of 104 recorded tax vote events. That arithmetic is not a tax-rate census. The eight Nays are eight recorded actions in her S0135 CSV. They are not flattened into one Nay. They are not copied from another member. This paper does not invent a ninth Nay. The eight Nays, named and unflattened, are SV713 on SB30 (Suetterlein Floor Amendment item 3-5.24 #1s rejected, 19-Y 21-N 0-A); SV714 on SB30 (Sturtevant Floor Amendment item 4-14 #6s rejected, 19-Y 21-N 0-A); SV744 on SB388 (Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by Senate); SV949 on SB129 (House substitute rejected by Senate, 0-Y 40-N 0-A); SV950 on SB661 (House substitute rejected by Senate, 0-Y 40-N 0-A); SV1431 on SB661 (Conference report agreed to by Senate, 25-Y 14-N 0-A); SV1511 on SB661 (Conference report agreed to by Senate, 23-Y 15-N 0-A); and SV1513 on SB661 (Conference report agreed to by Senate, 23-Y 15-N 0-A). All eight Nays sit in Regular. Special I has zero Nays. SV949 and SV950 are House-substitute rejections by the Senate. They are procedural/version, not policy opposition to the underlying bills. On HB30 conference report agreed (SV39), Bennett-Parker's 20262 token is Yea; there is no 20261 SV39 token in this thin CSV. On SV49, the 20262 token is Yea; there is no 20261 SV49 token in this thin CSV. Sessions stay separate. SB661 SV1458 (Senate requested second conference committee) is Yea for Bennett-Parker. SV1512 is Yea. Do not invent SV404; it is absent from this CSV. Do not copy Boysko SV1458 Nay onto this member. Do not copy Perry Spec I SV49 Nay. High Yea is not ideology.

There are 17 Present/Not Voting (X) tokens in this tax universe. Disclose X=17. All 17 sit in 20261. None sit in 20262. Many are Voice Vote HISTORY sentences. Keep them as X. Voice Vote X stays X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. Shared-refid VSV937 is X across HB163; HB282; HB474; HB524; HB557; HB1358 and remains one KPI event. Shared-refid SV748 and SV956 are Yea for Bennett-Parker. The 17 X vote_ids are VSV877, VSV878, VSV879, VSV880, VSV937, VSV939, VSV940, VSV941, VSV942, VSV943, VSV944, VSV945, VSV946, VSV947, VSV948, VSV949, and VSV1094. There are 0 Present (P) tokens. There are 0 Abstain (A) tokens. A=0. Special I is 15 Yea on HB30. This paper does not invent other Special Session tax bills.

Interpretive caution. A high Yea rate does not mean Bennett-Parker uniformly favored higher taxes or lower taxes. The captured bills include relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, local taxing authority, administrative changes, committee rolls, voice votes, and budget vehicles with very different fiscal effects. Fifty-three of the 104 events are HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30 budget-vehicle rolls. Vehicle is not item. X is not N. Disclose X=17. A=0. Spec I is all Yea. Thin coverage means early Regular tax floor votes without an S0135 token are not scored as X and are not backfilled. High Yea is not ideology.

1. Quantitative Tax Profile

Categories are assigned from official LIS titles only, using the same buckets as the Martinez sample where the title clearly fits. Seven shared-refid events attach to more than one tax bill and are scored once (Budget / Appropriations when a forced budget vehicle is among the bills; otherwise Tax Administration / Other) so the

table sums to 104 events rather than splitting a single roll call. Six of the seven shared-refid events are Yea; one is X (VSV937). Budget vehicles sit in Budget / Appropriations because this filter forces HB29/HB30/SB29/SB30. X is a recorded Present/Not Voting token. It is not Nay, and it is not absence. There are 17 X, 0 P, and 0 A. The eight Nays sit in Budget / Appropriations (SB30 SV713, SB30 SV714), Tax Exemptions (SB388 SV744), and Sector/Excise Tax (SB129 SV949; SB661 SV950, SV1431, SV1511, SV1513). Disclose X=17. There is no scored A.

2. Nay Votes

Documented Fact. Eight Nays. Seventeen X. Zero P. Zero A. The seventeen X tokens are named in section 3. There is no A token to name in section 3. The eight Nays named below are Bennett-Parker's S0135 CSV tokens. Those are separate recorded actions. This paper does not invent a ninth Nay. All eight sit in Regular (20261). Special I has zero Nays. House-substitute rejections by Senate are procedural/version. High Yea is not ideology. High Yea is not a tax-rate census. Keep sessions separate. SV744 is Nay for Bennett-Parker. SV1458 on SB661 is Yea for Bennett-Parker. Do not copy Boysko SV1458 Nay. Do not copy Perry Spec I SV49 Nay.

Nay: SB30 — Budget Bill. Vote SV713 on 2/26/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S Senator Suetterlein Floor Amendment item 3-5.24 #1s rejected (19-Y 21-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is a floor-amendment vote on a forced budget vehicle. It is not a standalone tax-rate roll.

Nay: SB30 — Budget Bill. Vote SV714 on 2/26/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S Senator Sturtevant Floor Amendment item 4-14 #6s rejected (19-Y 21-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is a second floor-amendment vote on the same budget vehicle. It is not flattened into SV713.

Nay: SB388 — Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Vote SV744 on 2/27/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by

Senate. Bennett-Parker's token is N. Accede, conference, and Governor's recommendation events on SB388 in this CSV are Yea. Do not flatten SV744 into those Yea rows.

Nay: SB129 — Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Vote SV949 on 3/4/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S House substitute rejected by Senate (0-Y 40-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The Senate rejected the House substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. Conference report on SV1428 is Yea in this CSV. Early Senate-passage tokens for SB129 are absent from this thin CSV and are not invented.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote SV950 on 3/4/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S House substitute rejected by Senate (0-Y 40-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is a procedural/version vote. The Senate rejected the House substitute unanimously. It is not policy opposition to the underlying bill. SV1458 is Yea. SV1512 is Yea. Conference-report Nays SV1431, SV1511, and SV1513 are named below. Do not invent SV404.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote SV1431 on 3/13/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S Conference report agreed to by Senate (25-Y 14-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is a conference-report Nay. It is not flattened into SV950. Later SV1458 second-conference request is Yea for Bennett-Parker.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote SV1511 on 3/14/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S Conference report agreed to by Senate (23-Y 15-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is a second conference-report Nay. Reconsideration SV1512 is Yea. SV1513 is a separate Nay after reconsideration.

Nay: SB661 — Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Vote SV1513 on 3/14/2026 (session 20261). Official recorded action: S Conference report agreed to by Senate (23-Y 15-N 0-A). Bennett-Parker's token is N. This is the post-reconsideration conference-report Nay. It is not flattened into SV1511. SV1512 reconsideration is Yea.

Analysis. The eight Nays are two SB30 floor-amendment events (SV713, SV714), one SB388 Counties/Cities/Towns amendment rejection (SV744), one SB129 House-substitute rejection (procedural/version), one SB661 House-substitute rejection (procedural/version), and three SB661 conference-report events (SV1431, SV1511, SV1513). House-sub Nays are not a tax-rate census. Spec I has zero Nays. SV1458 is Yea, not Nay. High Yea is not ideology. Do not invent a ninth Nay.

3. Present/Not Voting (X) and Abstain (A)

Documented Fact. Seventeen Present/Not Voting (X) tokens. Zero Abstain (A). Zero Present (P). X is not N. X is not Y. X is not absence. A is not N. A is not X. A is not Y. A is not absence. Disclose X=17. A=0. Many X rows are Voice Vote HISTORY sentences. Keep them as X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. Do not invent additional X rows. All 17 sit in 20261. None sit in 20262. Special I is 15 Yea. SV744 on SB388 is Nay for Bennett-Parker, not X. Early Regular tax floor votes that omit S0135 are not recorded as X and are not backfilled.

VSV877 — VSV877 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendments agreed to (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV878 — VSV878 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendment Item 77 #1s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV879 — VSV879 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendment Item 4-5.04 #1s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV880 — VSV880 / HB29 (2/19/2026): S Committee amendment Item 4-14 #2s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV937 — VSV937 / HB163; HB282; HB474; HB524; HB557; HB1358 (2/26/2026): S Passed by for the day Block Vote (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV939 — VSV939 / SB30 (2/26/2026): S Uncontested Committee amendments agreed to Block Vote (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV940 — VSV940 / SB30 (2/26/2026): S Contested Committee amendments agreed to Block Vote #1 (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV941 — VSV941 / SB30 (2/26/2026): S Committee amendment item 109 #3s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV942 — VSV942 / SB30 (2/26/2026): S Committee amendment item 125 #5s agreed to (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV949 — VSV949 / SB30 (2/26/2026): S Reading of amendment waived (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

VSV1094 — VSV1094 / HB1100 (3/6/2026): S Passed by for the day Block Vote (Voice Vote). Bennett-Parker's token is X. Keep it as X. X is not N and is not Y and is not absence.

There are 0 Present (P) tokens, 17 Present/Not Voting (X) tokens, and 0 Abstain (A) tokens. The eight Nays named in section 2 are N, not X. Shared-refid VSV937 stays X and stays one KPI event. Shared-refid SV748 and SV956 are Yea for Bennett-Parker. Special I has zero X tokens. This paper does not invent Spec I X rows for Bennett-Parker.

4. Real & Personal Property Tax

Titles below are the official LIS short titles. The one-line description of what each bill does is that title. Votes cite official HISTORY text. Shared-refid property titles that appear only inside block events are listed once in section 7 so a single roll call is not narrated twice. Exact personal-property vehicles in this CSV include HB557 where scored. Do not invent subcommittee tokens absent from this CSV. Do not backfill bills omitted by the thin S0135 join.

SB181. Real property tax; partial exemption for repurposing underutilized structures for residential use. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, S House substitute agreed to by Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (21-Y 18-N 0-A).

HB282. Real property tax; classification of land and improvement in Cities of Charlottesville/Falls Church. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/2/2026, S Passed Senate (40-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB557. Tangible personal property tax; establishes classification for electric landscaping equipment. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/2/2026, S Passed Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A).

5. Income Tax, Credits & Exemptions

HB1180 passage SV556 (2/19/2026) is the first tax-universe HISTORY date in this thin CSV and is Yea. HB400 passage-with-substitute SV891 and SV893 are Yea; reconsideration SV892 is Yea. SB388 carries Nay on SV744. Accede, conference, and Governor's recommendation on SB388 are Yea. HB1279 and HB167 appear where exact events exist in this CSV. Do not invent committee tokens absent from this CSV. Do not invent bills absent from this thin universe.

HB1180. Income tax, state; free tax filing program for individuals. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate Block Vote (39-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB400. Motion picture production; increases aggregate cap on tax credit, extends sunset. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (25-Y 15-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Reconsideration of Senate passage agreed to by Senate (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (24-Y 16-N 0-A).

SB388. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Bennett-Parker recorded Nay on 2/27/2026, S Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by Senate; Yea on 3/4/2026, S Senate acceded to request (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (21-Y 17-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (21-Y 18-N 0-A).

HB167. Tax exemptions; Confederacy organizations. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate (21-Y 17-N 0-A).

HB1279. Affordable housing; religious organizations and other nonprofit tax-exempt properties. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/2/2026, S Reported from Local Government with substitute (9-Y 6-N); Yea on 3/3/2026, S Constitutional reading dispensed Block Vote (on 2nd reading) (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (21-Y 17-N 0-A); Yea on 3/10/2026, S Senate insisted on substitute (40-Y 0-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (23-Y 16-N 0-A); Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (23-Y 16-N 0-A).

6. Sales, Use & Local Taxation

Admissions-tax and retail sales vehicles in this ledger are drawn from exact bill events in the S0135 CSV. Shared-refid block events that concatenate sales or local titles are listed in section 7. Do not invent subcommittee tokens absent from this CSV.

HB550. Admissions tax in counties; retail sales and use tax dedicated to promotion of tourism. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate (24-Y 14-N 0-A).

HB341. Plastic bag tax; distribution to towns. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 2/19/2026, S Passed Senate (22-Y 16-N 0-A).

HB524. Tourism improvement districts; transient occupancy tax in Arlington County. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 2/23/2026, S Reported from Local Government and rereferred to Finance and Appropriations (8-Y 7-N); Yea on 3/2/2026, S Passed Senate (21-Y 19-N 0-A).

HB915. Local taxation; tax extension for federal government shutdown. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate (39-Y 0-N 0-A).

7. Business, Excise & Tax Administration

SB129 and SB661 House-substitute rejections (SV949, SV950) are N and remain procedural/version as named in section 2. SB661 SV1458 is Yea for Bennett-Parker. Reconsideration SV1512 is Yea. SB661 conference reports SV1431, SV1511, and SV1513 are Nay. SB129 conference SV1428 is Yea. HB1100 carries X on VSV1094. Do not invent SV404. Do not invent bills absent from this CSV.

SB129. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Bennett-Parker recorded Nay on 3/4/2026, S House substitute rejected by Senate (0-Y 40-N 0-A); Yea on 3/13/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (26-Y 12-N 0-A).

SB661. Va. Small Business Economic Dev. Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Bennett-Parker recorded Nay on 3/4/2026, S House substitute rejected by Senate (0-Y 40-N 0-A); Nay on 3/13/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (25-Y 14-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, S Senate requested second conference committee (33-Y 6-N 0-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (23-Y 15-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, S Reconsideration of conference report agreed to by Senate (38-Y 0-N 0-A); Nay on 3/14/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (23-Y 15-N 0-A).

SB788. Alcoholic beverage control; payment of excise tax on beer, wine coolers, and wine, penalties. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, S House Amendments agreed to by Senate (39-Y 1-N 0-A).

SB302. Peanuts; excise tax, sunset extended. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/10/2026, S House substitute agreed to by Senate (39-Y 1-N 0-A).

HB145. Fantasy contests; regulation and taxation, civil penalty, repeals Fantasy Contests Act. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 3/4/2026, S Passed Senate with substitute (27-Y 13-N 0-A); Yea on 3/14/2026, S Conference report agreed to by Senate (26-Y 13-N 0-A).

SB597. Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on 4/22/2026, S Senate concurred in Governor's recommendation (39-Y 0-N 0-A).

HB1100. Wage garnishments; treasurers' liens for unpaid taxes and charges. Shared-refid block events

Seven unique vote_ids attach to more than one tax bill. Each is one KPI event. Titles are concatenated in the CSV with a semicolon-space joiner. Bills are not invented, and the block is not flattened into one bill's recorded position. Six tokens are Yea: SV699, SV748, SV866, SV887, SV956, and SV958. One token is X: VSV937. Keep VSV937 as X. Do not convert it to N or Y. SV748 and SV956 are Yea for Bennett-Parker.

Act; established, regulation and taxation of skill game machines. Official recorded action: S Senate acceded to request (40-Y 0-N 0-A).

8. Budget Vehicles (HB29 / HB30 / SB29 / SB30)

HB29, HB30, SB29, and SB30 are forced budget vehicles in this filter. They are not a standalone tax-rate roll. On SB30, Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on committee and floor vehicles that join in this CSV, X on eleven Voice Vote / block-vote committee-amendment and reading-waiver events (VSV939–VSV949), and Nay on SV713 and SV714 when the Suetterlein and Sturtevant floor amendments were rejected. Those Nays are floor-amendment events on a forced budget vehicle. Keep the Voice Vote X rows as X.

On HB29, four committee-amendment Voice Vote events are X (VSV877–VSV880) and other exact HB29 events in this CSV are Yea. SB29 has no exact event in this thin CSV and is not invented. On 20261 HB30, Bennett-Parker recorded Yea on Senate passage with amendments (SV888) and on shared-refid events that include HB30 (SV866, SV956). There is no 20261 SV39 or SV49 token in this CSV. Sessions stay separate.

20262 is HB30 only: 15 events, all Yea, including conference report agreed (SV39) and Governor's recommendation Nos. 1–14 (SV45–SV58, including SV49). Spec I is all Yea. There is no Special I Nay. There is no Special I X. There is no Special I A. Do not invent other Special Session tax bills. Vehicle is not item. The complete recorded actions are in Appendix A.

9. Intelligence Assessment

Evidence-supported characterization (Analysis). Bennett-Parker supported 79 of 104 recorded tax-universe events. The eight Nays are eight recorded actions: SB30 Suetterlein floor amendment rejected (SV713); SB30 Sturtevant floor amendment rejected (SV714); SB388 Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected by Senate (SV744); SB129 House substitute rejected by Senate (SV949, procedural/version); SB661 House substitute rejected by Senate (SV950, procedural/version); and SB661 conference report agreed (SV1431, SV1511, and SV1513). Those eight are the complete Nay set. All eight sit in Regular. Special I has zero Nays. House-sub Nays are procedural/version. SV1458 is Yea. There are 17 Present/Not Voting (X) tokens, including many Voice Vote HISTORY sentences in Regular. Disclose X=17. Keep them as X. Do not convert Voice Votes to N. There is 0 Abstain (A). A=0. Special I is 15 Yea on HB30. Because the universe includes tax relief, exemptions, credits, classifications, taxing-authority measures, administrative changes, committee rolls, voice votes, and budget vehicles — and because early Regular coverage is thin — the record is better described as broad support for the Senate majority tax-policy agenda represented in this corpus among the events that exist, with a documented eight-event Nay set concentrated on two budget-vehicle floor-amendment events, one SB388 amendment rejection, two procedural House-substitute rejections, and three SB661 conference-report events, and with seventeen Present/Not Voting tokens and zero Abstain tokens, than as a higher-tax or lower-tax posture.

Bennett-Parker has seventeen Present/Not Voting (X) tokens in this tax universe, zero Present (P) tokens, and zero Abstain (A) tokens. X=17. A=0. X is not Nay and is not absence. Shared-refid events SV699, SV748, SV866, SV887, SV956, and SV958 are Yea. Shared-refid VSV937 is X. On HB30 SV39 and SV49, Bennett-Parker's 20262 tokens are Yea; 20261 SV39 and SV49 are absent from this thin CSV. SB661 SV1458 and SV1512 are Yea. SB661 SV1431, SV1511, and SV1513 are Nay. Do not invent SV404.

Comparative significance. Differences with other members, if they exist, are more likely to show up in which bills those members oppose, miss, or break on — including Bennett-Parker's floor-amendment Nays on SV713 and SV714, her SB388 amendment Nay on SV744, her procedural House-substitute Nays on SV949 and SV950, her SB661 conference Nays on SV1431, SV1511, and SV1513, her SV1458 Yea, and her thinner early-session coverage — rather than any invented ninth Nay or any Spec I Nay that is not in this CSV. This ledger is behavior, not motive. Vote tokens do not establish why she voted. This paper does not invent votes or a tax posture from party or district labels. This ledger is S0135 only. Hashmi S0108 tokens are not scored. Ebbin S0085 tokens are not scored. House LIS id H0334 is not scored. House LIS ids are not scored.

Open Question. Version text on the SB129 and SB661 House substitutes versus later conference reports is not compared in this paper. Floor-amendment item text on SV713 and SV714 is not lined to any single tax item. Why Voice Vote rows carry X rather than Y or N is not established by the vote file beyond the recorded tokens. Why SV1431, SV1511, and SV1513 are Nay while SV1458 and SV1512 on SB661 are Yea is not established beyond the recorded tokens. Why S0135 is omitted from many early 20261 VOTE.CSV rows is a source gap, not answered by this paper.

10. Priority Follow-Up Research

- Thin coverage — First tax-universe HISTORY date is 2/19/2026 (SV556). S0135 is omitted from many early 20261 VOTE.CSV rows (1347 raw tokens vs ~2226–3371 peers). Do not backfill. Do not invent earlier votes. Do not score omissions as X.
- SB30 SV713 / SV714 — Keep the two floor-amendment Nays as separate recorded actions. Do not flatten them. Voice Vote X rows VSV939–VSV949 on SB30 stay X.
- SB388 SV744 — Nay on Counties, Cities and Towns Amendment rejected. Accede, conference, and Governor's recommendation on SB388 in this CSV are Yea.
- SB129 SV949 — House substitute rejected by Senate is procedural/version. Conference SV1428 is Yea.

- SB661 SV950 — House substitute rejected by Senate is procedural/version. SV1458 and SV1512 are Yea for Bennett-Parker. Do not invent SV404.
- SB661 SV1431 / SV1511 / SV1513 — Keep the three SB661 conference Nays unflattened. SV1458 is Yea for this member.
- 20262 HB30 — Spec I is 15 Yea. No Spec I Nay. Do not copy Perry Spec I SV49 Nay. 20262 SV49 is Yea. 20261 SV39 and SV49 are absent from this thin CSV.
- X=17 — List all 17 from the KPI All tax-universe X table (VSV877-VSV880, VSV937, VSV939-VSV949, VSV1094). Do not convert Voice Votes to N. VSV937 shared-refid stays one X event.
- A=0 — No Abstain token in this tax universe. Do not invent an A.
- Shared-refid blocks (SV699, SV748, SV866, SV887, SV956, SV958, VSV937) — six Yea and one X. Do not treat a concatenated title as a single-bill position.
- HISTORY join gaps: 105 unjoined 20261 vote_ids and 11 unjoined 20262 vote_ids were not scored as tax. Bills were not guessed.
- 20262 HB30 Governor-recommendation text versus any tax item remains unmapped. Vehicle is not item.

The official Senate member page body for S0135 was empty on fetch; district description list supplied the locality. Members.csv columns on disk are MBR_HOU, MBR_MBRNO, and MBR_NAME only; they do not print party or district. - Thin coverage (source gap, not a filter rewrite): S0135 appears in 1347 unique 20261 VOTE.CSV rows versus roughly 2226–3371 for other Senate-batch-1 members. First tax-universe HISTORY date is 2/19/2026 (SV556). Earlier floor tax votes have no token for this member — not recorded as X; the member id is omitted from those rows. Do not backfill.
